PREFACE

These “*Stories From Heaven*” could not have been given to the world at a more appropriate time than now. The world is in a terrible state of corruption and confusion politically, religiously and socially. Honesty, modesty, genteelness and morality seem to have been eliminated from our way of life, at least in effect if not consciously. However, God has given the world a Miracle it needs.

On July 28, 1967, *The Miracle Of Saint Joseph* was formally announced to a True Mystic. God had chosen a woman to give us the sound direction, hope and example we need. It was not the first time God had chosen a woman to accomplish His Purpose, always for a specific task in a particular time. This True Mystic for our day is Frances Marie Klug. She resided in Southern California as a wife, a mother, and a grandmother until her death on November 15, 2009.

In This *Miracle Of Saint Joseph*, Many Saints have come forth to speak through Frances Klug. These “*Stories From Heaven*” are just a few of the thousands of Revelations received through her. Very often these

Revelations were preceded by extensive Teachings which time and space did not allow us to put in print. However, some of these Teachings will be found in several of the many Volumes of "*Stories From Heaven*".

In these Revelations The Saints refer to Frances as "the child", "the funnel", "the spoon", "the instrument" and "the little one". God made her our Spiritual Mother. For many years now, because of this fact, she has been called "Mother Frances", or simply "Mother". Heaven also refers to people of all ages as "children" and emphasizes time and again, This Miracle is for people of all races, all colors and all creeds.

For someone turning the pages of these "*Stories From Heaven*" for the first time, they will easily recognize the sound logic and sound direction the Messages contain. Mother Frances heard the Words with the Ears of her Soul, and would repeat Them aloud when she was told to do so.

This Teaching Miracle is a direct parallel to the time Our Lord walked the earth. He did not loudly proclaim to everyone, "I am The Son of God." He taught in a quiet manner, simple, extensive, but always detailed

in repetitiveness, instilling in those listening what He wanted them to remember. He taught in parables, short, simple stories containing moral lessons. He knew men could more easily understand and remember the point He was trying to make this way. His “Teaching Stories” pertained to everyday living, practical matters, and how to become a Saint. He gave hope through these stories. He gave example.

Now in our time, God is once again giving us “Teaching Stories” through Saint Joseph and His instrument, Mother Frances. Through her, in a quiet, unassuming and genteel way which appears so “natural”, mankind is again being taught the Purpose of life, and what God expects man to be like in his daily living. People feel hope in these Teachings, Example always given.

Two major Revelations of significance have been given for us in our day. Our Heavenly Mother is Part of The Divine, and Saint Joseph is truly The Holy Ghost. These should not bring an immediate rejection, but should pique our curiosity and interest.

Our Faith in God is based upon many mysteries. Whether it be The Holy

Trinity, the Incarnation of God, or The Holy Eucharist, men strive to understand These, trying to grasp a small glimpse of the Beauty of the Truth They Are. These mysteries also pique our imagination and interest. However, even though we know God revealed these mysteries to mankind and we accept them in Faith, they still remain just that, mysteries.

One has only to look at these “*Stories From Heaven*” to see the value They are, and to feel the hope They instill. No man can logically deny purity of thought when it is so obvious. No man can deny purity in direction, when it is based on sound morals, sound values, sound standards. Do not be blind to truth. Skepticism is for people who are unable to see the truth of a matter or situation, and many times skepticism drowns out purity because it is full of ego and pride in one’s self. Skeptics find it an easy out to disclaim truth.

There is no doubt that it takes time for such Phenomena as This Miracle to penetrate even those minds who feel they are capable of discerning such Phenomena. We must not be governed by purely another man’s determination, but we must understand that logic, sound reasoning and purpose must be the criteria of our Faith in God.

“My itinerary for the day:

I awaken.

I take care of my personal needs.

I prepare myself for the physical and mental action I am accustomed to.

I utilize my habits of procedure to attain my goals of necessity, of desire, of purpose.

I live, not just exist in a world of action, in a world that changes every moment of the day and yet remains the same in most ways.

I relate to the news of the world.

I relate to the happiness or unhappiness of others with whom I speak, I hear about, or who I am associated with.

The big question for my daily itinerary is: How much time have I spent with God, if any at all? Have I referred to God with respect, in

conversation, in direction to others or through my example?

Do I go to His Place, my church, visit Him and tell Him that I love Him, or do I find this too time-consuming, too much out of my way, not necessary?

If I pray, do I pray selfishly or with little respect? Do I realize when I pray, Who I am talking to and the Reality of His Being, His Hearing, His Understanding, and the reason for prayer in my life? Do I remember daily that it was He Who gave me the time to have my itinerary?"

**“LOOK AT THE FOLLOWING REALISTICALLY.
ASK YOURSELF: IS THIS ME?”**

I don't need to be reminded of things to do regarding my Faith. I believe in God and I have practiced my Faith in the way I know how. I feel that I am doing my best. I feel I live by the Ten Commandments. I feel I go to church as often as I can. I feel that my life is clean, and I also feel that even if I wanted to improve my life I would still have to live up to what other people do in my time of life. I don't consider myself bad. Granted, I am not perfect, but I do consider myself normal, which is more than I can say about some very righteous people who go to church all the time.

**LOOK AT THESE STATEMENTS REALISTICALLY.
NOW ASK YOURSELF THESE QUESTIONS:**

What do you base your life on, your practical scope of things? Possibly it is the best you can do, but is it all you can do? Have you limited yourself in areas where only you control the fashion of how you project your beliefs in God? Do you extend yourself beyond your self-satisfied

mood of spirituality? Do you honestly recognize the Value of your Spiritual growth, the unlimitedness vantage and advantage God has allowed you, or do you limit your own Spiritual progress through laziness, self-induced lethargy, or a feeling that to love God more, serve Him better, grows stronger in loving Him in obedience to His Rules and Mandates?

Do you accept less when you could have more? Do you truly recognize the Power He Is, the Strength He Is, His Supremacy in all things? Are you satisfied with poverty, Spiritual poverty, only because you neglect working for a higher place in Heaven? Do you say to yourself, ‘I guess I just don’t have the Faith or the drive or the desire’? Do you say, ‘God understands me’? Do you accept this trite statement? If you do you are speaking for God. Do you have this right? Is this not an immature, lackadaisical cop-out to accepting the responsibility of seeing Faith in God as the ultimate life support of living, for living, in living?”

SEPTEMBER 23, 1983

“Every man has a method of doing things; some men practice what is termed ‘ordinary’ to other men, some men have peculiar methods, peculiar only because they are not consistent in an order used by other men.

GOD’S TEN COMMANDMENTS are Mandates, Commands, Rules, that must be followed by all men. There is no chance for peculiarities to be considered. There are no definite methods that men can determine other than to be based on Truth, sound moral action, thought and deed. Moral values, immoral values, can be seen as the right and the wrong of doing things.

Men cannot say that another man has a method of obedience to GOD’S TEN COMMANDMENTS, nor can he say a man has peculiar habits or practices regarding GOD’S TEN COMMANDMENTS. GOD’S TEN COMMANDMENTS are structured in such a manner and way that there can be no guesswork or personal assumption or presumption, opinion

or theory, in determining the Facts God projected in how He wanted man to live a moral and pure life with the Goal of Sainthood for his Soul.”

“The world has progressed in a mechanized way. A form of robot is being used to speed man’s actions, to release man from the labor of physical strains, permitting man to utilize the power of mechanical knowledge, implanted by man, for producing a more modernistic and thorough, detailed exactness, within depth precision not visible to the eye of man or the mechanical ability of man’s physical makeup. A machine can look inside man, but we must never forget man’s intellect, talents and decisions on what he sees, determines the course of action proceeded upon.

Let us, you and I, look at putting our Faith in God into a piece of machinery, bearing in mind at all times that this piece of machinery is incapable of Faith in God, does not have a Soul, does not have a will and does not have a Guardian Angel. Let us look at this realistically. All the professional mechanical inventions man can produce cannot create a Soul, cannot have Faith in God, and cannot give to man life forever. This does

not mean that mechanical devices are wrong, but the Lesson to be remembered is this: the human being is the greatest, most loving creation of God, with a Purpose far greater than any great invention man can devise.

As you walk through each day and you comply with your personal itinerary, keeping things in your own order, some of you totally involved with the latest equipment man can dream up, never forget, only you are in control of your Soul, Its Purpose and Its Goal. You are not a robot run by other men. You are the custodian of a will. You are knowledgeable thoroughly on GOD'S TEN COMMANDMENTS. You are the decision maker of your own self-disciplines. You are the only one who can control your temper, your anger, your gluttony, your lust, your soundness in values. No one can push a button to make you do what they will you to do.

You have the right, you have the freedom, you have the control to obey God by obeying HIS TEN COMMANDMENTS. Excuses are only excuses. So, never forget, being made to the Image and Likeness of God must be paid back, by imitating

HIS Goodness through obedience to HIS TEN COMMANDMENTS, imitating HIS Love through obedience to HIS TEN COMMANDMENTS, remembering charity to all men because of the Charity shown in the Gift of God by HIS TEN COMMANDMENTS.”

“A man’s character is what others see and what others react to. His character can display gentleness, rudeness, aggressiveness, simplicity; also, many types of emotions, pride, ego, and insensitivity, according to the mood or the character he wanted others to feel, or what his habits of his personal nature and personality automatically express. Man is made up of so many types of actions, abilities, capabilities, and dispositions.

The Holy Family came to the earth to be Example for mankind to follow, to show mankind the importance of family life, the beauty of purity in procreation, and the value to be good example.

Men are shouting, ‘I am equal to you; I possess the same freedoms that you possess, the same qualities, and of course, the same abilities, rights, and permission to do what I want to do, and to act how I want to act.’

Men forget one thing: The Holy Family set Example. Theirs was a life

of living in the same manner others did, working for monetary measures, suffering the ills of Their time and expected to die according to the physical way. They gave Expression of Hope because of Where They came from. It was eventually deduced They were Special. The men who interpreted these things were not all saintly men. Many were men of arrogance, critical, dominating; but in their arriving at what they saw to be a Divine Gift of Love, the power of their words, the strength of their words, the reality of their interpretation gave light, hope, passing down through time This Mystery of Pure Love.

It is said that a child should be created in and with love, a personal love, an intimate love. The nature of some people does not allow it to be a pure state, but this does not lessen the Example that was given in the Conception by The Holy Ghost to The Royal Family, called 'The Holy Family'.

It is time for man to realize that permissiveness, promiscuity, immorality must cease and stop being accepted as natural to man, instead of a responsibility morally for man.

When a Soul is instilled into the conception of human life the Soul is Pure, the child is Pure; the sin of the parent is not on the child's Soul. Men must reflect on this and understand that purity of mind, body and Soul are the prerequisite to enter the Kingdom of God. Men must once again look to the Ten Commandments and obey Them."

“There is nothing in the whole world, money, nuclear warfare, man’s abilities or capabilities to dominate people or situations, that supersedes the power of prayer. Prayer is many things to all people. To some it is a spontaneous few words spoken or merely thought; to others it’s taking the time to act in a special manner, showing the action of prayer to others, its commitment of service.

Each prayer, each manner of prayer, each form of prayer, each degree of prayer, each reason for prayer, each purpose for prayer and of prayer, is between the individual and Almighty God. Only He understands the full intention, commitment, reason, and of course, the best way to answer each one’s prayer. Prayer is most powerful because nothing exceeds the Power of God, nor His Will where man is concerned. His Way is always far-reaching and not always understood at the time, but we must be ever conscious that prayer is a living union

of communication with The Highest Power in existence.

Prayer is a fortress against evil, against failure. Prayer is the greatest force in existence against satan. Prayer should be a constant thing, not something we must be reminded to do, to rely upon. The strength in prayer, the power of prayer, says to God:

‘I believe in You, tell me what to do, lead me where I must go, strengthen me in what I must do and help me to return to You my Soul.’

Prayer can have no doubt attached to it because in prayer there can never be despair. There is trust in prayer, a child’s trust and yet a blind trust, because innately man knows the Existence of a Supreme Being that hears all things, sees all things and controls all things.

Make prayer a way of life through charitable acts, through sincere concern for the well-being of another human being, through times of special devotions to God alone, through unselfish deeds, through more understanding of the imperfections of others, using your own example as the

teacher, the instructor, rather than verbal confrontation, opening cause for debate rather than sound logical example.

There is peace and tranquillity in prayer. There is happiness in prayer, there is confidence in prayer, there is hope in prayer. Never sidestep prayer because you are too busy being involved in any form of activity, environment or social contact that puts prayer in a secondary manner.”

“Man instinctively puts boundaries on all things. He associates boundaries to control, ownership, or separating people, conditions, ideals, forms of government control, and many other forms of distinction that have reasons pertinent to the boundary conditions.

God is Boundless. God has no favoritism over one man than another man. God cannot be cut out of the lives of people by boundaries made by man, separating people, conditions, or whatever reason makes the boundary necessary.

We are dealing with an Unlimited God, a Boundless God, a God of All Wisdom, a God of All Power, a God Who constantly gives us opportunity, reason and purpose to follow His Rules, to seek Him in all we are, all we do, all we hope for.

Our color does not form a boundary of God’s Love. He does not say, ‘The color of a man determines My Degree of Love for Him.’

Nowhere has it ever been said or written He favors men in particular parts of the world. When God speaks it is to all His children, all races, all colors, all creeds, all ages, all backgrounds, all capabilities, all talents, all degrees of knowledge.

All men have One God. All men have His Ten Commandments to live by. All men have equal rights to serve Him, to pray to Him, to be committed to Him in a degree they choose. God has set no boundaries for man's love for Him.

It is important that each day of our life we look at our manner of living, our manner of prayer, our recognition of God's Will for us, and we take a solemn vow to eradicate from our way of life impurities of all sorts, uncharitable habits and prejudices against other men that are unfounded, and perhaps only nurtured by us because of others' opinions, others' dilemmas, others' weaknesses in these areas.

God bears no prejudice. God holds all men equal. God is The Giver of life and God has promised Eternal Life to all men. What better Goal can man

reach for? The first step is to see the reasoning to change one's behavioral patterns, habits, and personal ideals, then direct one's life to the Goal God intended for it: Sainthood."

“Define your interpretation of maturity, the stages by which and through which it is reached.

Is maturity a sense of financial success?

Is maturity having more than your neighbor?

Is maturity connected to your age?

Is maturity a sense of security?

Is maturity based on your acceptance of your own abilities to reconcile yourself to adjust to what you feel fate has dealt you?

Is maturity a form of understanding other people’s weaknesses?

Is maturity recognizing your terminology for dealing with the daily risks of life?

Is maturity, to you, based and founded upon the sound logic of the Reality of God and your responsibility to it? and to Him?"

“Closets are used for many things: clothing items, sports equipment, and numerous items; also items that are meant to be hidden for one reason or another.

Few people want or encourage another person to look in their closet, to go into their closet to retrieve an item or whatever else they might want or need. A closet is a private place; it encloses many personal habits, items, and many times hides things that are too personal to share with someone else.

Men bound to religious factions or beliefs have been known to hide their reasonings to perform in certain manners, basically unorthodox gestures, rationalizing their behavior, yet hiding the facts behind the doors of an imaginary closet. Such actions, though hopefully are meant to be secretive, eventually find their way out of the closet.

When something is truly of God it is never hidden in a closet. The

mere goodness of it, the logic in it, the soundness in the benefits to the Souls of all men never permit secrecy, or it to be hidden beyond man's reach.

All Truths where God is truly connected are in the Winds of His Power and on the Power of His Winds. What is truly of God and from Him remains for man to see it, understand it, and it bears sound reasoning to follow it, even when men in professed dedication in God's Name, to His Name, theorize to satisfy their opinions, determining through interpretations what justifies conditions that will aid, support, or adjust a matter regarding Faith in God and what other men must believe or accept.

All through time men have lost sight that God, as a Supreme Being, sees into the closet of men's minds: selfish reasoning, prideful gain and false self-esteem. Even though there have been many mistakes by men, through time, leading other men to believe untruths or declared truths based on personal theory and personal opinion, the fundamental basic truths of life automatically show to all men the Logic, the Soundness, the Mercy, the Love, the Hope and the Justice

in God's Ten Commandments, which, without a doubt, forms the basic structure of religion, of Faith in God, for all races, all colors, all creeds of people.

The Birth of Our Lord, documented, has given to the world a further step of the True Presence of God, and the bond between His Commandments and how He expects man to live according to Them, plus the Purpose of the physical life, for each man to ascend into Heaven with That Portion of Himself, the Soul.

As Christ is yet known to us by the Name He bore upon the earth, we are to live, through our Soul, with the name we bear while living the human life.

Another Perfect Gift of Love, the Sacrifice of Divine Love, Christ's Gift of leaving for mankind more than a symbol of His Love, but through the Act of Consecrating a species of food, announcing that This Food would nourish our being with Himself, a Portion of Him instilled into this Species would be as our Soul is to us, forever binding our physical purpose of life with our Spiritual Purpose of

“Men speak of the old world and men speak of the new world. Men speak of the historical events. Men value historical events. All historical events were not critical to man’s immediate life nor to man’s Purpose for life.

Bible History consists of parables. These parables are reasoned out by men who feel they have the ability to detect and to see the full meaning described in the parables. The condensed version of a whole story is in a parable. Such responsible action, determining the full concept of parables, must bear with it the Truths intended in the condensing of such Important times and issues.

We must also remember that parables came to us through the minds, abilities, and interpretation of languages different than ours, and of course, redone for our benefit in languages that involve many dialects structured by zones, wherein the nature of the zone geographically determined the translation.

History, Political, Historical, Biblical, is first made, secondly recorded, third emphasized in facts, theory and results. The amazing part of History that is recorded automatically omits details, personal conflicts, rights, problems, potentials, and effects that cause the results.

We are now living in a time of making History, perhaps with more actual recording than any other time in History.

Political, Physical and Bible History are a constant part of life, as both Political and Physical History are never-ending, due to the very existence of man. So also Biblical History is forever in the making, as long as man has Faith in God, and acts in this Faith, practicing what God intends as an endless Code of life, His Ten Commandments.

From the day each of us is born we are a part of History.”

“Men count the days, men keep track of the hours, men specify in their lives a determined amount of work they will produce each day. Men plan for goals, monetary and physical abilities, plus taking advantage of talents they feel will benefit them, using skills for self-satisfaction, self-esteem or even glory.

Time is important to man, for time is what man uses to obtain or gain satisfaction in many areas of life.

Time, in essence, is man’s sole means to expand mentally, physically and spiritually, using his knowledge, his wisdom, his protective human mechanisms, and his Faith in a Supreme Being.

So many times a man allows everything to be first, before the things that will benefit his Soul. Personal feelings, ideas, opinions, desires, and his senses, strive to accommodate the basic human feelings pertaining to self, rather than to examining the real

Importance of life, the Purpose of it: for it to return to God the Soul.

Many men preach eloquently, but are remiss in the sound teaching that man must constantly be reminded of, the Soul.

Men work at a vocation. They see, feel and realize this responsibility is important, necessary, and has benefits to support their way of life. Mostly this dedication to vocation is based on a monetary measure, or a goal to acquire self-esteem in the eyes of other men.

With all the up-to-date emphasis on evangelization, there is little sound teaching regarding the basic Truths of the Purpose of life. Men are shouting to be reborn. Reborn to what? How could there ever have been a question that God did not exist for them at any time of their life?

There is much responsibility when man faces the commitment to dedicate to God a promise of living a more fruitful life, serving God above all others and all things. This is not and cannot be a moment of emotional outward expression, but it must be realistic and bear the responsibility

it announces, it proclaims, it commits to.

Only time will prove the sound commitment to God and to one's self. Time is a precious Gift of Divine Love, and should never be abused or confused in a way of treating it lightly, frivolously or without responsibility.

Time should be used wisely, always considering Who the Giver of it is, Who the Creator of it is, and Who will be the Judge of it at a specific time."

NOVEMBER 1, 1983 AT 8:45 A.M.

“Television has brought the world close to what is occurring throughout the world. TV is, in true essence, sound reasoning, a phenomenal asset to man. Through it we are alerted momentarily to dangers, the threat of danger, and what other people are enduring because of the natural elements and/or the devastation of people to people. This tremendous Gift of advancement gathers men from throughout the world, joining their intellects, their dreams and their experiences, sharing these to a degree with other men who, without television, would never have the opportunity of such communication.

On the other hand, TV is being used as a demoralizing amphitheater of destruction, corrupting the moral values of people throughout the world. As there is so much purpose, benefit and good derived from the morally sound communication in TV, why do men permit such immoral destruction to occur right in front of their eyes? Is it just money? No. Of course, this

is a major factor in such obvious contamination, but throughout time satan has used men, and women, of course, to exploit the avenues that base themselves on totally abusive conduct regarding the human body, denying the True Existence of the Presence of the Soul within the body. Some might call this 'sheer defiance for shocking purpose only', others might call it 'entertainment, earthy entertainment'.

A Soul is as a beautiful diamond to each of us. Our Soul is linked to

every portion of our human body. The purer we behave, the Beauty of our Soul is seen, even by the worst of men. It is up to each of us to not scar our Soul so much that no one is able to see through our actions, our charity, our mercy, our love, our justice, our integrity, the Beauty of our Soul. It is a horror to think our Soul could be the recipient of our immoral behavior to the degree that our Soul is like a diamond in the rough. The Beauty is covered but the Value is at the mercy of our discretion or indiscretion, our greed or our morality in all things.”

Man’s life is so far beyond the physical aspect, and yet it is through the physical time on earth, Sainthood is the Reward.

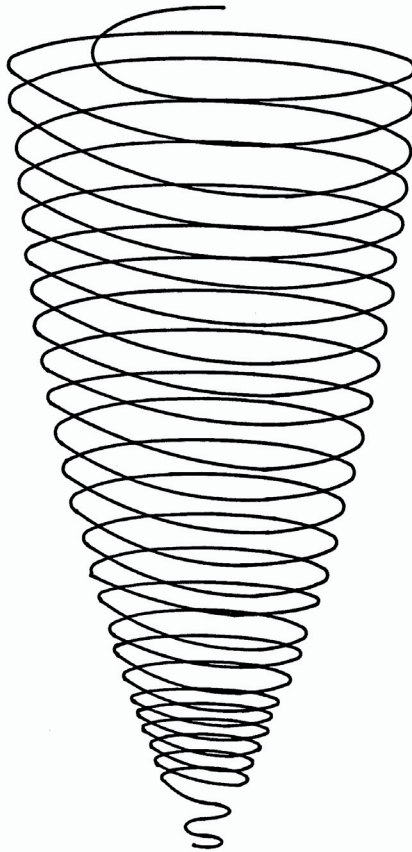

Am I selfish, sneaky, curious, unduly inquisitive, secretive, just to save my own neck?

Am I possessive, controlling, stealing the rights of someone else, or their freedom of choice, conscience, will?

Do I act consciously, or just act indifferent to the consequences of my actions?

Do I ever consider obedience to God's Commandments as my responsibility and obligation to uphold them with dignity, honor, understanding, in the purpose They were given to obey?"

Attitude can be a healthy, sharing, loving treasure of hope, and allowing everyone else to feel hope, energy and interest.

The so-called ‘Jesus Movement’ has many down sides because the ATTITUDE that is expressed is the humanism they relate to in The Son of God.

All facets of this are not totally wrong, but in many, many areas of its emphasizing Jesus, has and is eliminating His Divine Origin.”

People who follow fanatic leadership, do not look beyond the surface of the control. They become brainwashed by the force of control that is undeniably superior in its dictatorship.”

“RUSSIAN ROULETTE”

“Any activity potentially destructive to its participants.

Ask yourself:

- 1. Would I knowingly kiss someone on the mouth if I knew they were in an advanced case of tuberculosis or any other communicable deadly disease?**
- 2. Would I risk becoming the victim of AIDS, casting aside the reality of its deadliness, but also casting aside the Sixth Commandment?**
- 3. Would I knowingly allow others to dare me to play Russian Roulette in any area of immorality because I feared ridicule?”**

“CURIOSITY”

“A desire to learn about things that do not properly concern one, being unduly inquisitive.

Curiosity, when it is constructive, can be beneficial, but when it is based on an individual need to be informed or involved in something or someone’s life that is personal, this type of curiosity can be destructive to the individual, or individuals, victimized by the perpetrator’s lack of moral ethics.”

“EGOTISTICAL”

“Self-centered, selfish, conceited.

This trait in an individual’s personality and/or nature, is not just an annoying feature or interference of others’ enjoyment in being with the individual, but can be an obnoxious and irritating association.”

“NOSEY — INQUISITIVE”

“An individual who is constantly concerned over other people’s activities, personal lives, because

of their prying where it interferes with the other individual's actions, lifestyle, friendships, and/or way of life, can make mountains out of molehills in their misinterpretation of many things."

"GOSSIP"

"This manner of communication can be one of the most destructive forces, because in its very essence it becomes opinion, rather than fact, truth, or decency in many ways."

"All the above topics can be like a fungus that grows and grows and grows, many times destroying a reputation, a situation, that in its own state of existence could be very constructive, and has as its goal something that has only good intentions."

“The responsibility of one’s commitment to his or her moral obligations in all areas of life, must be superseded by one’s moral obligations to God’s Commandments.

“Logic has responsibility in every area of life, because it automatically follows a sound balance of right over wrong, good over evil, good sense over nonsense, and is always based on the value of the subject or situation over the negative, improper, incorrect and/or immoral result.

Thus, logic is sound realistic behavior, intended to not tolerate or participate in actions, activities, immoral or outrageous fads that only diminish the dignity of human life.”

A mental advisor should never be totally acceptable because of, or on the basis of, a degree in psychology or therapy. A Spiritual advisor must be acceptable on his or her obvious moral concepts, practices, and integrity.

When a person is of sound mind and uses his or her will to walk in the daily responsibilities of living, it is important that their own judgment on issues of daily living should be guided by and guarded by sound moral values and sound moral standards.”

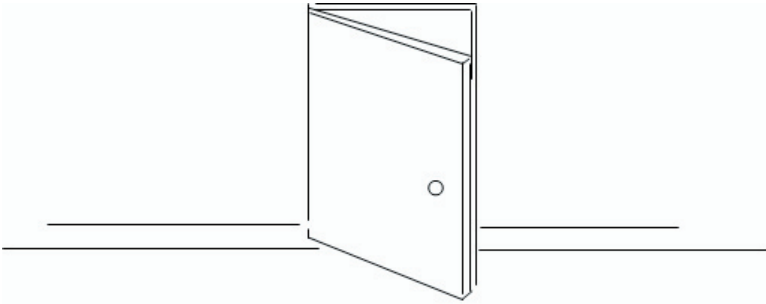
