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PREFACE

These “*Stories From Heaven*” could not have been given to the world at a more appropriate time than now. The world is in a terrible state of corruption and confusion politically, religiously and socially. Honesty, modesty, genteelness and morality seem to have been eliminated from our way of life, at least in effect if not consciously. However, God has given the world a Miracle it needs.

On July 28, 1967, *The Miracle Of Saint Joseph* was formally announced to a True Mystic. God had chosen a woman to give us the sound direction, hope and example we need. It was not the first time God had chosen a woman to accomplish His Purpose, always for a specific task in a particular time. This True Mystic for our day is Frances Marie Klug. She resided in Southern California as a wife, a mother, and a grandmother until her death on November 15, 2009.

In This *Miracle Of Saint Joseph*, Many Saints have come forth to speak through Frances Klug. These “*Stories From Heaven*” are just a few of the thousands of Revelations received through her. Very often these

Revelations were preceded by extensive Teachings which time and space did not allow us to put in print. However, some of these Teachings will be found in several of the many Volumes of *“Stories From Heaven”*.

In these Revelations The Saints refer to Frances as “the child”, “the funnel”, “the spoon”, “the instrument” and “the little one”. God made her our Spiritual Mother. For many years now, because of this fact, she has been called “Mother Frances”, or simply “Mother”. Heaven also refers to people of all ages as “children” and emphasizes time and again, This Miracle is for people of all races, all colors and all creeds.

For someone turning the pages of these *“Stories From Heaven”* for the first time, they will easily recognize the sound logic and sound direction the Messages contain. Mother Frances heard the Words with the Ears of her Soul, and would repeat Them aloud when she was told to do so.

This Teaching Miracle is a direct parallel to the time Our Lord walked the earth. He did not loudly proclaim to everyone, “I am The Son of God.” He taught in a quiet manner, simple, extensive, but always detailed

in repetitiveness, instilling in those listening what He wanted them to remember. He taught in parables, short, simple stories containing moral lessons. He knew men could more easily understand and remember the point He was trying to make this way. His “Teaching Stories” pertained to everyday living, practical matters, and how to become a Saint. He gave hope through these stories. He gave example.

Now in our time, God is once again giving us “Teaching Stories” through Saint Joseph and His instrument, Mother Frances. Through her, in a quiet, unassuming and genteel way which appears so “natural”, mankind is again being taught the Purpose of life, and what God expects man to be like in his daily living. People feel hope in these Teachings, Example always given.

Two major Revelations of significance have been given for us in our day. Our Heavenly Mother is Part of The Divine, and Saint Joseph is truly The Holy Ghost. These should not bring an immediate rejection, but should pique our curiosity and interest.

Our Faith in God is based upon many mysteries. Whether it be The Holy

Trinity, the Incarnation of God, or The Holy Eucharist, men strive to understand These, trying to grasp a small glimpse of the Beauty of the Truth They Are. One has only to look at these “*Stories From Heaven*” to see the value They are, and to feel the hope They instill. No man can logically deny purity of thought when it is so obvious. No man can deny purity in direction, when it is based on sound morals, sound values, sound standards. Do not be blind to truth. Skepticism is for people who are unable to see the truth of a matter or situation, and many times skepticism drowns out purity because it is full of ego and pride in one’s self. “LIAR”

“A liar is a very difficult person to be with, for when a person is known to lie, the relationship becomes unstable, weak, undependable, and there is always a fracture in our belief no matter what the subject is.

It goes without saying, a liar is his own worst enemy, because a liar bases thoughts, words, actions and deeds on untruths, which not only dampen a situation, but makes it unworthy to be heard or involved in.

Most people who lie believe their own lies. This does not make it fact, but in this belief, it justifies to them what they have said. This justification does not change the lie.

Our society today is based on immorality, in the acceptance of improper, impure actions, thoughts, words and deeds. Our society is *sick* because it relies on false standards, false values. Our society is a society of lies, of desecrations, of blasphemies, of immoralities, of impurities, based

on humanism, constantly defacing the necessity of Faith in One True God, and so many people denying there is a Heaven and there is a Hell.

Only God is All Powerful, and all human beings are dependent upon Him. The structure of the human body is prone to incapacitation and sickness, and men have a limited mental capacity, so how can man *justify* lies that make important decisions that involve the Soul when he relies totally on humanistic evaluations and values, accepting *moral corruption* rather than recognizing and following sound moral values and sound moral standards for the good of his mind, his body and his Soul? Immorality stems from lies. It all stems from liars who convince themselves first that this is what they believe, and then convince others it is what they should believe.

Ask yourself these questions:

Do I lie easily?

Do I believe my own lies?

Do I lie constantly?

Do I force others through my dominance to believe my lies?

Do I use my lies to control situations?

Do I use my lies to control people?

Do I lie to justify my weaknesses?

Do I lie so others will not see me as I am?

Do I live a lie?

Do I laugh when people lie to me?

Do I lie for attention?

Do I lie to God?

When one looks at the pattern and results of a liar's path, one cannot help but see a total lack of integrity, a total lack of dignity, a total lack of self-control, a total lack of self-discipline, a total lack of self-esteem, a total lack of understanding, a total lack of sound values, a total lack of sound standards,

a total lack of True Faith in God, a total lack of a sound mind.

To confront a liar with his or her faults, it is amazing to watch the defensive tactics of the liar. Sometimes rather than their recoiling against the attack, they attack with further lies, becoming more offensive, more arrogant, more insolent, appearing positive, always trying to make the other person look stupid, ridiculous, but always defacing the truths, and sometimes even showing a force in a demonic gesture of reproach.

Liars should not be treated gently. They should be treated at their own game, but with such truthful measures that their defiance *breaks itself down* against the *strength of pure truth*.

There are some people who lie incessantly about everything, and do it with such charm, assurance and positiveness that the person on the receiving end does not see the liar for what he or she is.

Let's put this into its proper perspective. A lie has barbs in it, and the barbs usually cause a hurt, an injustice, degradation, or desecration to something good. There is no doubt

that it is easier to not confront a liar, but there is also no doubt that a liar has to be stopped somewhere, sometime, somehow.

At this time in our life, for many people, lying has become a way of life. All the immoralities that people and society accept as normal ways of life are based on humanism rather than on God.

If lies are corrected when they are first recognized, there is little chance for them to grow to a disastrous state of existence, allowing them to be so ingrained in society and people, that people do not recognize what is happening.

‘Live and let live’ got out of context. It should have been this way: Live with God in mind at all times so others will follow your example.

**“WHAT IS THE HOLY GHOST?
WHO IS THE HOLY GHOST?”**

“The Holy Ghost is a Part of God that He shares with us in many ways. The Holy Ghost is the *Light of God’s Love* for mankind. The Holy Ghost is the *Dispenser of Faith in God*, and the *Coordinator* of this Faith according to the *time* in which we live, the *way* in which we live, and the *heritage* that we have received through time and other people; plus, The Holy Ghost, in Wisdom, *considers* our heritage, environment, and the means and measures available to us in our time of life, so that we have the proper proportion and benefits to do the Will of God for the good of our Soul.

The Holy Ghost is defined by God as the Wind of His Power, and as the Power in a Particular Wind that belongs to God alone, that He shares with man through allowing This Power the freedom to move throughout the world to touch all men in a particular way.

The Holy Ghost is that Portion of God that is in constant union with man to keep man aware of God, of the Importance of God, the Greatness of God, and of course, Who God truly is, a Supreme Being.

It is The Holy Ghost Who, acting through our Faith in God, gives strength and support to our belief in God and encourages us to have more love for God, plus more desire to one day be with God. The Holy Ghost has the Power to be in all places in the world at one time.

When man thinks of wind, he thinks of it in different degrees, sometimes gentle, sometimes forceful, sometimes almost totally destructive, for wind itself comes in many degrees. The Wind of The Holy Ghost is never destructive. It is always constructive because It is that Part of God that gives Foundation to Faith in God, that gives Stability to man's Faith in God through the Truths where God is concerned.

The Holy Ghost is not a separate Power of God. It is the Power of God, and that is why it is difficult for some men to believe, to understand, or to

accept without seeing, that The Holy Ghost is the unseen Force holding Christianity in its place in spite of all the immoralities, indignities, blasphemies that men allow, partake in, and generate through indecencies and impurities.

The Holy Ghost established Holy Mother Church in its very beginning, which makes The Holy Ghost The One Who established Christianity in a way that men could understand, in a way that men could relate to with human reference, human relationship.

No man would have understood at that time that this Carpenter could be God, or any Portion of God, nor could anyone at that time have believed that this Woman was The Mother of God. This is most certainly proven when they could not believe that The Son was the Messiah. Man is so limited in his understanding the Magnitude of God, the Magnitude of God's Love, and the Magnitude of God's Sincere Purpose in creating mankind.

The very physical of man is so unique in its structure, in its faculties, in its very performance, that it is sound to believe, sound to understand that

this tremendous Creation of God had a Purpose beyond other creations.

The intellect of man, the ability of man to recognize and to speak out about *The God* that man is aware of, the innate feeling man has of concern for other men's welfare, says man was created to the Image and Likeness of God.

“A SOUND LOOK AT THE ROSARY”

“There is little understanding in regard to the full importance of the Rosary. Many people cling to it because holding the Beads makes the prayer feel a bond of true communication with Our Heavenly Mother. This is good.

There are more important reasons for the Rosary, and of course, they're obvious in the thoughts of people. The Holy Rosary is one of the most important prayers to ward off satan. The prayers in the Holy Rosary say everything he hates to be said. The prayers say more than is sometimes realized by those who say the Rosary daily. The continuity of the prayers keeps the enemy, God's and man's, out of the picture.

Some people say, ‘I say the Rosary, but I really don't concentrate on it.’ Some people say, ‘I say the Rosary on my fingers when I don't have the Beads with me.’ Some people say, ‘I lose count, but it is a habit with me.’ Some people say, ‘I find it difficult to

say because it is so long.’ Some people say, ‘My intentions are good, but by the time nighttime comes I’m just too tired.’

Let’s straighten everyone out right now. The Rosary is a positive, definite form of armor against satan. It is not only the armor, but it is the best weapon anyone can use. It is even more than the weapon; it is the driving force that repels all evil. First, the Crucifix on the Rosary is of the utmost importance. It depicts how The Son of God freed man. It also depicts God’s Great Love for man. It also shows the truth of Christianity. It also portrays, without a doubt, the Final Consummation that was left with Holy Mother Church, the True Body and Blood of Christ.

This Crucifix also says many things to God’s and man’s enemy. The prayer in its very essence honors God, tells about God, and commits the one who says it to sound belief in God, Our Heavenly Mother, the Virgin Birth, and all the important issues that the enemy of God and man envies, hates, and fights against.

The next three beads are said with three very important things in mind, and they should be concentrated on, not skimmed over, because the repetitiveness of these three thoughts gives them the importance they should have in everyone's life: Faith, Hope, Charity. In many instances, many people have referred to the Charity as Love, which is right, for Charity is True Love.

The very Mysteries of the Rosary are reflections on important times that satan would hate man to look at, to remember, to reflect upon, because the concentration is on God.

And now we come to the '*Our Father*'. There can be no greater love than to honor God through the Very Words He gave us Himself. Needless to say, satan hates These Words.

Now as we begin the '*Hail Mary*', the repetitiveness of this prayer is a great aid to rejecting satan, and as this prayer should be a continuous prayer in the hearts and the minds and the lips of every human being, it should be understood that satan cannot enter when this prayer is said.

Our Heavenly Mother, God's Mother, Our Blessed Mother, Our Heavenly Queen, is Purity beyond what we can understand, what we know purity can be, and She has the Power to stomp out evil with a mere thought, and when Her children pay Honor to Her, She protects Her children from the enemy.

The Rosary is a powerful prayer, more powerful than people realize, for it is, in its continuity, in its content, that satan is cast aside and cannot enter. The power of the Rosary must be seen by all people throughout the world. It is a shield, it is a weapon, it is the greatest act of prayer man has. The Rosary is prayer in action, for every prayer in the Holy Rosary speaks of the Importance of God, the Greatness of God, and of course, the Magnitude in which Our Heavenly Mother stands.

A wise man, a wise woman, a wise child would never be without the Rosary. Say it, keep it on your person, and never go to bed without it under your pillow. Keep it close, not in a fanatical way, but in a wise way. Realize the importance of it, and keep it as your armor against satan."

“CHRISTIANITY”

“Christianity is being threatened even though there are a countless number of men and women shouting passages from the Bible, shouting, ‘Praise the Lord, Alleluia.’ In many cases it is just that, shouting. In the repeating the passages from the Bible, the translations are not always correct, and many are ill-founded. Interpretation of the Bible is very important, because when inexperienced opinion translates words that are passages only, this can be dangerous.

The word ‘Christian’ for many years was almost set aside, and the emphasis was on forms of religion, Roman Catholicism, Protestant religions, and there was a dignity in each one; some, more dignity than others. Granted, all things were not as pure as they appeared, but there was an outward integrity and dignity that gave strength to the flock. Now what do we have? We have people shouting, ‘I’m a Christian,’ and of course, this is an important statement, but what

kind of Christian? What is the source of belief in this Christian? Is there stability in this belief, or is it a wild feeling about following Christ?

Religion must have order, it must have stability, it must have sound doctrine, it must have sound dogma, it must have background of solid truth. Holy Mother Church is this particular religion, and it has survived a countless number of years against heresies, schisms, power-hungry men, and fiendish plots.

Today Holy Mother Church is as Great and as True as It was since It was first founded by Christ Himself. Now it is just a case of putting things in order again. Many Roman Catholics have been misled and misguided. Others have been abused and mistreated because they did not go along with the radical, improper changes, steps, and ridiculous factions that have put The Holy Eucharist as a symbol, have placed The Tabernacle in an inconspicuous place, and who have backed the emotional, unrealistic beliefs that all, or many people have great power to heal and to do a multitude of other things. This implication shouts ego, and omits humility from the very core

of what Holy Mother Church stands for.

It is time that Roman Catholics recognize the Importance of Holy Mother Church and stop diminishing the structure that belongs to the sound values and sound standards that the Holy Father is trying desperately to uphold in the midst of chaos, turmoil, indifference and rebellion.

For reasons that can only be determined personal or opinionated, some men have undermined the dignity and the solemnity of many practices and Sacraments in Holy Mother Church through their opening the door to laymen, encouraging, and in some cases, forcing them to participate in many of the Sacred ceremonies and activities that should be performed only by those who have accepted the responsibilities of a religious dedication to the Priesthood.

Many of these abuses to the structure of Holy Mother Church vary in parishes or dioceses, and the reason, or reasoning for laxness regarding the importance of so many acceptances that involve Holy Communion, Baptism, Blessing of

the Sick, and numerous other things, depends upon the individuals who stand in authoritative positions as to what determines the course they will sanction.

There is no doubt that Holy Mother Church will get back to where It should be, the difficulties will be solved and the reorganization, or perhaps even the re-establishment of Holy Mother Church will be necessary. Sound specific rules and regulations will force solemnity, stability, and sound structure to return to its rightful place.”

“PRAYER MEANS FAITH”

“How do you pray?

What do your prayers consist of?

Is prayer necessary to you?

Do you allow others to see you pray?

Do you only pray in privacy?

How do you honestly feel about prayer?

What do you feel prayer should show — piety, solemnity, fanaticism, or do you think that prayer is only a private communication with God?

Where your Faith in God is concerned, is it an open Faith, is it a well-guarded Faith, is it a well-guided Faith?

Do you have a padlock on your Faith? Do you lock it up when you do not want to be aware of it, or have others see you use it or practice it?

Do you understand the necessity for Faith in God?

Are you aware of others' Faith in God?

Do you believe in the necessity to use Faith in God in acts of charity, in acts of hope, in acts of love, in acts of humility, in perseverance, in example?

Today, be sure that if you have a lock of any kind on your Faith in God, open the lock and throw the key away, for it could be that through your expression of Faith in God, someone will see reason to love God more, and have more hope in life.

Be aware of the importance of how you pray, where you pray, your intention in prayer, and combine this with an awareness of your Faith in God, and the necessity of expressing your Faith so that others will learn how to grow in the Light of your Faith, so that their Faith will also grow."

“LOST? — YOU COULD BE.”

“Have you ever been lost?

Were you lost just because you became disoriented in the direction that you were going?

Have you felt lost because of what you knew others expected of you?

Have you ever felt lost where God is concerned?

In any of these areas of being lost, logic says that a person must stop, look at the situation and then make a sound decision on what direction to take. Also, routine that seems comfortable does not always signify that the person is not lost. To not be lost in any way takes concentration on every act, every move, every thought one makes. Being lost can sometimes be summed up as ‘walking with one’s head in the clouds’.

Today, with all the shouting of Christianity, charismatic gifts,

emotional relationships through Marriage Encounter, sensitivity programs and Youth Ministry, it is obvious that many people are lost. It is obvious that they are walking in a maze of concentration on themselves based on a false imagery of what is within themselves to do.

In the *Marriage Encounter* there is a fanatical emphasis on the importance of being submissively sensitive to extremes in regard to one's spouse, placing too much emphasis on the sensitivity of weak points that must be catered to, compromised with, and constantly be aware of. This quest for an idealistic relationship puts marriage in a category that eliminates the spontaneity of sound caring and room for an individual to be themselves.

Sensitivity programs are destructive programs because they do not just *appeal* to the senses, but in some cases *attack* the senses to respond beyond what the person would ordinarily do. Sensitivity programs justify forms of dependence, blind trust, submissiveness, and readily introduce permissiveness.

Youth Ministry does not ring with a clarity of sound supervision, sound direction and sound leadership. Just because an individual is found to be likeable, understanding, and endowed with a certain amount of ability to deal with people, especially young people, does not give them license to lead young people in all the matters of morals, nor does it give them the credentials to counsel others. The emphasis on Youth Ministry has a lot to be desired, and it should not be totally accepted just because someone in authority says it's right.

The *Charismatic Movement*, comprised of individuals who firmly believe they are instruments with special, extraordinary abilities, powers and gifts, cannot be recognized and accepted for what they have chosen to believe of themselves. The Charismatic Movement is filled with emotionalism, instability, and some egomaniacal human beings who act and who swear that they have the gifts to use that are extraordinary, and of course, powerful, making themselves important, in some cases even controlling others to depend upon them for physical cures.

In the Crucifixion of Our Lord, He showed how important it was for men to stand alone. He could have forced all the Apostles to stand with Him in His hour of need, but in His standing alone, strong in what He knew was right, He showed them that they were individuals, and they must not lean on anyone, that they must go forward on their own recognizance, using their own will, calling upon their own knowledge, based on their own understanding of what He wanted of them, and they would teach nations because of the strength in them individually, and that it would be through this individual strength that they would give other men strength and example. He did not want them in bondage; He allowed them the use of their own will.

As the world goes today, because of the immoralities everywhere, men are allowing themselves to be put in a bondage that is frightening to see: the bondage of dependence on others, the bondage of being only a follower, the bondage of submission to wrong authority, wrong morals, wrong direction.

The shield of honor on any battlefield is to protect the warrior. In the time in which we live, the *SHIELD* we must wear, must carry, must use, is the *SHIELD* of a sound Christian, the *SHIELD* of following Christ in the way He intended us to follow, in the manner He intended us to see as His Example for us as an individual.

The Rosary is the greatest *SHIELD* we can have against immorality. We don't have to carry a twenty or thirty pound piece of steel. All we have to do is carry a Rosary and say it with the intentions we know Our Blessed Mother wants us to have, and wants us to be example of. There is no greater *SHIELD* in the world than the *SHIELD* of Her Rosary."

“WHAT’S HAPPENING?”

“It is easy to see what is happening. All one has to do is open one’s eyes, and also listen to what is being said. The answer to this question is evident, obvious, and in *no way* is it *hidden* from anyone.

The question really isn’t ‘What is happening?’ The question is, ‘What is going to be done’ about what is happening? In every area of life moral values can be said to be the ‘whole core’ of action, motion, motivation, and way of life for all people.

People speak more of morale than morals. They join in all types of perverted activities, all sorts of compromises, to keep the morale as the goal of their association and their social obligation to and with everyone else, but the *moral values* and the *moral standards* are not allowed to interfere with the social, liberal, unorthodox, immoral involvement they feel and accept as their normal obligation to be normal in the time in which we live.

Sound Morals, Sound Values, Sound Standards have been set aside or even buried by the familiarity that people have succumbed to through their perverted actions, their immoral adventures and ventures, tossing the Ten Commandments of God aside, and dwelling totally on humanistic indecencies to the point of morbid pleasures.

Ask a man who has just sinned if he had a good time. If he says, 'Yes,' then ask him what his terminology for 'good' is. You will find a very mixed-up human being, either totally emotional or bordering on total emotional instability.

The solution is obvious, but to get people to see the necessity for things to change is difficult:

The laxness in *home life* in some cases can be an important factor;

The laxness in *school authority* allowing immaturity to control rather than the school authority standing taut on all school rules and procedures;

The laxness in *businesses* permitting familiarity amongst the employees, advocating social involvement and ignoring the responsibilities of the employees to their spouses and to their families;

***Social* familiarities, looking for new thrills, new excitement, lacking a responsible stand of a mature, sound moral attitude, relationship;**

A lack of usefulness regarding sound justice;

People living *beyond* their means, seeking a status that keeps them totally indebted to others rather than facing the standard of life their financial abilities and capabilities permit.

To correct the wrongs takes sound logic and a sound sense of how God would want things done. All through time there have been periods in which people lost their sense of reality and relaxed their sound values and sound standards, because of the pressures that obscenities, blasphemies, impurities, immoralities made on the moral values that seemed

to be accepted by everyone. In some of these ugly times, moral decay seemed worse than others.

We are now going through a vile period of moral decay, and it will take a strong sense of the Ten Commandments as the Rules for life, plus more understanding of Who God Is, and why men were born, plus the Purpose of each man's Soul. A lot can be done about what is happening; it just takes good people to do it."

“Perhaps this is true. Have you asked yourself if *you know yourself?* Then ask yourself, do you want people to see you idealistically or like you are?”

What does it mean when people understand you? Is it because they agree with you, they never confront you, they never put you to task when you are wrong? Are you sure you are not confused with how you want people to understand you, or are you too weak to see the value in having to account to others for how you act, how you treat them, what example you extend in your moods, in your social graces, in your aggressiveness, in your dominance, in your peculiar manners, in your indifference to how they feel, in your selfish ambitions, in your lack of sensitivity, in your emotionalism, just to name a few?

In gaining the understanding of others, the first thing that you should do is to ask yourself if you understand

yourself, and if you like yourself. Would you put up with yourself if you were on the receiving end of all you are, all you do, and all you expect? Answer this in solid truth and then correct it in solid, sound, logical ways, and then you will never have to say again, ‘People just don’t understand me.’”

**“I’M AFRAID OF LIVING
AND I’M AFRAID OF DYING”**

“Why was I born? I can’t bear the thought of dying. If I had it my way, I would not have been born. If I have it my way, I will never die. Few people go through life not thinking at some time about these two very important times of life.

If sound Faith in God is established within a human being, then the question ‘I’m afraid of living; why was I born?’ will have an answer that is logical, complete, sound, and comforting.

Of course, man was born to become a Saint, to live with God for All Eternity, through living a physical life the way God intended life to be, always working with one’s intellect, talents, nature, personality and commitment to achieve the true purpose for the physical life, procreation and the responsibilities attached to it, plus passing sound morals, sound values, sound standards to others through

sound moral living in every facet of human life.

If you look at life with such purpose, if you look at living with the hope for a Greater Life, then the concern of 'Why was I born?; I'm afraid of dying,' would never enter one's thoughts for very long.

To be afraid to die could be lessened in many ways. First of all, a life of fulfillment gives soundness and automatically gives reason to the necessity for going on to even a more fulfilling way of life. The logic of dying is evident when one understands the limits of the physical and the true purpose for dying. If all men would look at life realistically, see the value of everything they have been given mentally, physically and spiritually, the evidence of balance in things will make dying right, reasonable, and logical.

The next time you are faced with any question regarding living or dying, remember what has just been said, and also, remember that your *will* is your *Line of Decision* and that it will be through your *will* that living is important to you, and that dying is just as important."

“Our love for God is determined in how we reflect our belief in the Ten Commandments, to what degree we uphold Them in our daily life, and in our manner of religious beliefs, coordinated with the example we are in every thought, word, deed and action that we permit ourselves to extend to others.

Sometimes we make so many excuses for our faults, our weaknesses and our self-love, that we fall short in how we portray our feelings, our actions, and our expression of loving God. There is no boundary, there is no figure in amounts, and there are no typical situations that we can use that we could say would be ample love for God.

The ability to love God, the willingness to love God, the practice of loving God has no bounds. The desire to serve God, the interest in loving

God, the love of doing things to please God has no bounds. No man who has ever lived or who will live, could ever decide what degree of love is ample for God. Knowing this, realizing this, understanding this, is logical, and should make everyone think that there could never be a limit to one's love for God, and that every moment of life should be in search of, and in readiness to seek all things that will be pleasing to God and obedient to His Ten Commandments.

“In our time there is so much emphasis on certain people who feel they have physical healing powers in their hands and/or in their prayers.

Looking at *healing* in its full and true sense can only be attributable to God first. Either He gives a *Miraculous Cure* or He gives people the mental and/or physical strength to *endure* the illness, or He sees that *time* takes care of the mental and/or physical capabilities to deal with the problem.

When there is no physical evidence of the possibility for health to return, only God is in control, and the stability of the situation comes from the *will* of the person and of those associated with the person.

Prayer is most certainly to everyone’s advantage. At no time is prayer ever harmful when it is for good.

So-called healers, *self-endowed*, must be seen for what they are — eager to help, but sometimes their ego is the only strength they have.

Healing devices are many:

- 1. Prayer.**
- 2. Medical Science in the hands and minds of competent people.**
- 3. Activities that generate thinking about something else until the body restores itself.**
- 4. Sometimes learning a subject that gives some challenge takes one's mind off of the immediate problems.**
- 5. Working with one's hands on projects helps to avoid depression.**
- 6. Getting interested in the Arts many times gives new interests, and helps the mind conquer the personal fears.**
- 7. Changing one's color scheme in the house or refurbishing things gives a lift to one's**

spirit, encouraging a hopeful outlook.

- 8. There are numerous ways to ward off depression, anxiety, and/or fear. *Use them all if necessary.***

Physical healings do happen all the time and in many ways. Just don't depend upon an individual who insists they have charismatic gifts to heal.

When God uses an individual for such purposes, it is done discreetly, and the instrument is not hailed as a great charismatic.”

**“CORRECTOR — CORRECTED —
CORRECTION”**

“Why does it seem easier to be the *corrector* than the *corrected*? To be the *corrector* is not always a comfortable position, and to be the *corrector* takes tact, understanding, sincerity, knowledge, also to be in a position where it makes the correcting necessary.

The *corrector* must be sure that the correction isn't just criticism, or a means to vent one's emotions, or to satisfy a mood. The *corrected* must look at the value of the *correction* and see the need for the *correction*.

As we look at the above Statement, we might first think It is a tongue twister and then forget It. Please look at the above Statement for the worth It is to you, for the value of Its content, and for the help It can give when you are on either side of the fence in that very touchy area of *correction*.

The Ten Commandments, in many ways, are the *correctors* of our behavior, our values, our standards, our morals, our beliefs. They are Commands and They are Rules, but the very essence of Them says *correct* what you are doing wrong, use the Ten Commandments as the *correctors* of your faults. Perhaps this is why fewer and fewer people are holding the Ten Commandments as the Guidelines for life.

We live in a society of false values, and this society does not take to correction very easily, because it has become an insecure, egotistical society that lacks sound values and sound standards, and does not want to be told about it. So many things are based on illogical, irrational, immoral, lewd, vile attempts at living.

A dignified code of dress, dignity in social manners and in social graces seems to have become unthinkable, and when it is brought up, it is rejected with ridiculous statements. In fact, dignity seems to be tagged as something that does not belong in today's society.

Holy Mother Church was the leader in morals, and when the authority of Holy Mother Church tore down the walls that spoke stability, honor, dignity, hope, God's Love for mankind, and substituted the walls with compromise, illogical changes, diminishing the structure of the Priesthood, opening the doors and letting all types of man-made religions to enter the structure of Holy Mother Church through misinterpretation and false understanding of what Ecumenism truly *meant*, it had a direct effect on the whole world. Many men may not agree with this Statement, but results of the vast changes within Holy Mother Church have had a direct influence on many people and many things.

When the men in Holy Mother Church *relaxed rules* and *permitted a lack of dignity* in the code of dress, and stressed that certain actions in protocol upon entering the church could be eliminated, plus their ignoring many of the Sacramentals, it put *indifference* as acceptable and this flowed into some of the Sacraments.

This stretching of acceptable behavior went further than the people

could have ever suspected it would. It opened the doors to many other man-made religions, and naturally, those who were invited came. Even some who were not invited came, because of the draw to the One True Church that Holy Mother Church definitely had.

We would like to think this is what happened: The men who interpreted Ecumenism did not foresee the surge of inevitable compromise that would force issues they were unprepared to handle in the true Roman Catholic way. Due to their inexperience in dealing with this type of compromise, it made their innate feeling of Christianity succumb to the lesser decision. Thus, the watering down of structure, standards, protocol and dignity became evident.

At the present time, Holy Mother Church has been compromised, and it is time that all Roman Catholics make the decision to stand up and be counted for what God intended Holy Mother Church to be: a fortress of Faith, Honor and Dignity, capable of warding off the ugly enemy, satan.

To rebuild, reorganize, and re-establish Holy Mother Church would

Work has a tremendous ability within its very function to give hope, to give strength, to give zest, to give zeal to living. Work in many forms

gives the mind something more than just contemplation, meditation or imagination, thus avoiding lethargy, laziness, boredom, or even senility to take over.

For some, work with the hands is a Godsend, for others, work with the mind is a Godsend. Be aware of the importance of working, and be aware of the importance of what work can mean to you. Never deny your mental, physical or Spiritual the importance of work.

Work can be the greatest means that you have to not just accomplishment, but to a healthy life of fulfillment. Don't try to get out of work, use it, and as you use it thank God for it, for it can be the very factor in your life that will lead you to a life of Total Fulfillment."

“CATECHISM OR CATASTROPHE”

“To answer questions regarding Faith and morals, one must have the basic knowledge and the ability to explain in a knowledgeable way the doctrine and the dogma from which and in which these questions apply.

When someone says to you, ‘You can teach religion, you can teach catechism; you don’t have to be learned in the subject,’ question this person immediately, and then be sure you know what they want you to teach, and be sure you have a sound background in the subject.

One of the important areas of Roman Catholicism is the basic catechism that should be learned from someone who does not treat this catechism as merely a question and answer book, but who has the ability to guide the Faith of a child or adult along with the information that the questions and answers imply, refer to, or express in fact.

In the last several years, the important task of teaching catechism has been handed to those who would do it, not always to those who were capable of doing it. Much of this *lack* in understanding the catechism, put the emphasis on sensitivity avenues, replacing sound knowledge of the subject with *uneducated* examples, *trying* to point out what was meant and how it affects them in their life. This resulted in a dangerous situation. By danger, it is meant it emphasized a sensitivity rather than the strength in the sound doctrine that should have been explained properly.

Let's do more about educating the educators. Let's stop accepting substitutes and *demand* qualified people as instructors of Roman Catholicism."

“Life should not be lived on a teeter-totter. Men should not teeter between right and wrong, but should be aware of the necessity to right over wrong.

In so many businesses, social obligations force men and women to ride a teeter-totter every day, balancing between Heaven and Hell, and sometimes feeling the weight that they are fighting, seemingly throwing their values and standards out of balance.

It is necessary for all men, no matter who they must deal with, to structure their lives with their values and standards first on what they know is sound for the good of their Soul. The struggle to permit one’s self to be in a critical state of right and wrong is really never necessary, because if one refuses to compromise and refuses to patronize for social or monetary reasons, then the teeter-totter is not a problem.

Never even allow a hint to anyone that you feel you are on a teeter-totter between God's Will and satan's desire. Never allow yourself to be looked upon as not having sound values and sound standards based on sound morals. Once you relax your morals, it is sometimes taken for granted by others that you have weak standards and weak values and that you can be compromised easily; also, that you are vulnerable to anything they choose to encourage you to act according to their wishes. Keep before you at all times, Sainthood My Goal."

“A LOT TO THINK ABOUT”

“Throughout the world, no matter where one goes, there is a sense of Godlessness in the attitudes and in the atmosphere around people. There is a lack of genteelness, a lack of refinement, a lack of sincere caring, a lack of respect, and a lack of dignity.

In the so-called sophisticated air travel that is common to our time in life, there is a lack of feeling for the passengers and among the passengers.

In visiting the different churches, there is no one in the church. The feeling is frightening. Now if we truly believe that God is in the church and He resides in The Tabernacle, and we have the privilege to enter and be in His Presence, then why are not more people visiting Him instead of just throwing a prayer out at their convenience? Why do not more people take the time and visit God in The Tabernacle?

It is important that Roman Catholics start recognizing the

Godlessness that is all around, and the importance of taking the time to visit in a personal way The God Who created all things. A habit of this nature by many people would cause a chain reaction for others to follow, because people would wonder what was going on in there. By nature, people are curious, and who knows how God would touch an individual who would be curious enough to stand in His Presence in The Tabernacle. It might be the act that could save this person's Soul, for you do not know how many times God tried to attract this individual and was ignored because this person was distracted in another way.

The Apostles continued to teach what Christ taught, but without their example, people would have not retained all that was said.

Many people make a living at mimicking other people, usually in jest for entertaining reasons, but every time someone is imitated or mimicked, that person is remembered by many. Outstanding characteristics are usually the points that are picked up to mimic or imitate. Why not then imitate the Apostles, Moses, The Holy

Family, and The Saints, so that what They did, how They lived, and what They left for all mankind can be passed on through you into time.

It is time that we begin to pass on good, rejecting the evil influence that is prevalent in the world. People are starving for someone close to God to give them what they need. There are so many people who are searching desperately for the strength in sound Christianity. The stories of The Saints should be made readily available. Not just the Bible should be talked about, but there should be an emphasis on Bible stories so that people do not have to interpret the passages, but can find what they are looking for in Bible stories. There should be a great effort in teaching about the founders of Religious Orders, what obstacles and good times they had.

There should be an emphasis on the Importance of The Holy Eucharist, the beauty of Novenas that form a special type of prayer for men to follow, Missions for the people to feel the strength of direction from men who sincerely want to encourage a growth of Faith and love in God. Triduums are another source of getting the attention

of groups of people and instructing them for a life of prayer, in a life of prayer; Retreats, with sound doctrine being taught, encouraging the beauty of the Sacrament of Penance and the importance of purity.

As we live now, we live in a pit of iniquity and depravity that is constantly fed by immoralities that involve the mind and the body, plus the continuous lack of obedience to God in every facet of human existence.

Man's *will* is a God-given Gift for all decisions man makes, but men must use this will with willingness to change what should be changed, correct what is wrong, or improve things to make them correct. The use of the will is not always a dramatic yes or no decision, but most often can be best described as a willingness to perform for accountable actions, accepting all responsibility for these actions.

It is time that people recognize the importance of the awareness, the willingness, and the performance of deliberate actions in working to please God more, in striving to make the Ten Commandments the Guidelines for life, and the practice of using every

traditional means to grow spiritually for the sake of one's own Soul.

Forget the gimmicks disguised as Christian behavior that trade only on sensitivity programs, emotionalism, and human weaknesses. Gimmicks are nothing more than tricks and attention getters, very often to get you to do something you shouldn't be doing, or that is totally for the benefit of someone else. In this sense you can be sure that only satan is the instigator for the gimmicks, for it is his method of using chance, deception, and tricks. When you look at what you have to gain, be alert to what you have to lose.

Sainthood is not the result of gimmicks, but of sound values, standards, and morals, dedicating one's life to serve God to the best of one's ability."

Most likely we all know of Souls in Purgatory, and it would be wise to not ignore this fact.

It is important for everyone to see how devastating to our Soul our slightest imperfection can be. With this knowledge it is difficult to understand why we do not wish to do everything according to God’s Plan. It seems impossible that we would dare

to sin against His Ten Commandments. Reason alone should make us change our way of living and reach only for purity in every thought, word, deed and action we are involved in.

How Do Souls Get Out Of Purgatory?

When the reparation is completed, and God is satisfied with the state of the Soul's being, then the Soul is released to one of the Castles in Heaven.

We can be of great assistance to the Souls in Purgatory, and it is sad that we often fall into the trap of a cliché that says, 'Out of sight, out of mind.' If we could but remember that we are never out of the View of God, and when we leave this earth our Soul is constantly seen by Him. So with this as a guide for our thinking, we must never omit praying, or performing acts of charity, service to God, or acts of love on behalf of *a Soul* or *the Souls* in Purgatory.

We are told, and we believe through Faith in God, that when we help a Soul out of Purgatory, this Soul, when It is with God, has the

opportunity to aid us in ways that we will not be aware of, but in the Plan of God's Justice, and in His Plan for Ultimate Charity, He allows this to happen.

What Is Purgatory?

It is a state of reparation for Souls to make restitution."

“Time is important to everyone. Some men feel their time is so important that they charge exorbitant prices when they use their time to instruct, to counsel, or to diagnose a physical problem. Others charge exorbitant prices for their qualifications alone, in their teaching credentials. Other men charge exorbitant prices for their capabilities that they feel are beneficial to you and that you hire them for.

Most men do not see the importance of their time that is spent for the benefit of their Soul. They put no price on this, they put no set value on this area of their life, and yet this is the most important time in anyone’s life.

Spiritual behavior, Spiritual involvement, Spiritual teaching, Spiritual direction, Spiritual instruction that guides Souls, that emphasizes the Purpose of life, the channels that must be taken to benefit the Spiritual Being, bears the most

important expression of time and its usefulness than anyone gives credit to.

Time is precious to most men, sometimes in selfish motives, or for selfish gain. But men oftentimes guard their time without reason; they just instinctively feel it is theirs to do with what they will. God, understanding the possessiveness that man feels about time, treats this subject delicately because time to God is also very important. The difference between man's feeling for time and God's Intention of time is that man is the recipient of time from God, and God is the Dispenser of time to man.

From this time on, be aware of how much time you devote to God, how much time is spent being example of Him to other men. Also, when you look at your clock, always remember to ask yourself, since the last time that you looked at the clock, how much time did you spend devoted to God for the benefit of your Soul?"

The *reality* of Holy Communion is Special for man, for through time It has been honored for what It is, and It has in many cases, shown Miracles when men were in need. The *reality* of Holy Communion passed down through time assures men that as It is a Substance understandable in the Miracle of Its change, It gives to us, Him.

Holy Communion's *place* in our life is the connection between our love of our Faith, our acceptance of our Faith, and our practice of our Faith, in What He did, What He allowed to be done, and What He left for us to always have: a Part of Him.

Holy Communion's *purpose* is to remind us of all that He taught, all that He wanted us to see, as our need for Him. Also the *true purpose* of Holy Communion was to never allow His children to be separated from Him.

The *beginning* of Holy Communion was displayed at the Last Supper, and Its Beauty was Consummated when The Son of God took His last Physical Breath for the good of man.

The *necessity* of Holy Communion to us and our Souls is endless in

explanation because It is timeless in Its entirety, and is beyond the expression of love man can have for the Beauty of one's Soul.

“YOU ARE AN APOSTLE”

“The first Apostles spoke sometimes to a few people at a time, and sometimes multitudes gathered to hear them speak about Christ. They told the people about Him, and they expounded on the subjects and topics He taught them.

They taught the people about life, its Purpose, about life everafter, and how It would be attained. They taught the people the necessity to obey the Ten Commandments and the Importance of Christianity. They taught all the people about this manner of life of Christianity, and what it was all about; how in Christianity men would reject barbarism, reject injustice, reject impurities of mind and body, concentrating on the necessity of purity of the Soul.

They taught about the necessity for men to respect other men, for honor to be upheld in the midst of men, and how the dignity for life and in life was important because in the act of dignity, it showed respect for

mankind, because man was made to the Image and Likeness of God.

They elaborated on how important it was for all men to hear of Christianity, and for all men to hold the Ten Commandments as their Guidelines for life. They talked about how important it was for men to learn from them, so they, too, could go and teach all nations, the Message that Christ left for all time.

They talked about the personal days with Him, how He led them, teaching them as they talked, teaching them day and night, sometimes with a rapidity of words, actions and examples, and other times in a more solemn way, a more somber way, showing them the necessity for seriousness. They told the people about their Soul, and what God expected of them because of this knowledge they now had.

They talked about Baptism. They talked about repentance for sins. They discussed the value of the marriage state and the family, and they always put great importance on the anointing of the sick.

They expressed great concern over the new necessity for Priests to

follow in this Christian form of life, and the protocol and the formula for instructing others in the way He set it up to be.

They talked about decency. They talked about the Beatitudes. They talked about charity, its purpose, its need, its dignity, its rightful place.

They talked about how important it was to protect the innocence of the young, the necessity to take care of the elderly, and to provide for those who needed it.

The life of the Apostles was busy, full, and in many ways, they walked in danger all the time.

In the time we live, we must continue doing things the way God wants them to be done, holding the Ten Commandments in an obvious place, not just to remind us, not just to guide us, but to keep us constantly aware that These are The Rules and The Commands to follow for purity.”

“God chose America for *The Miracle Of Saint Joseph*, and All His Directions and Teaching through This Miracle in America are in the English language, which allows all Americans to understand thoroughly All the Teachings and Directions.

It is logical to see that God, in using our language, will speak in a way readily understood by us, and His Terminology, Direction and Content will be understood by us and not foreign to us, or not force us to determine interpretation.

Many years ago, the terminology that was used in Aramaic, Greek, or any other language, would most likely not be how we would term ‘example’ or ‘parable’. The dialects of those days differed from each other, and would not suit or fit our way of life. In our day, in the tongue we know that is correct for us, God is speaking through *The Miracle Of Saint Joseph*, giving Direction for all of us to understand Him more, to help us grow in our Faith

in Him, and giving us sound reasoning in how we can become Saints.

There is no trickery in God, there is only Love for man in God, and His Love, coming to the earth to a portion of the world that speaks English, is His show of a Special Love for man. How can man ignore the Messages He has given and is giving? Are Americans so naïve or so supercilious that they cannot recognize a Gift of Extreme Love, Divine Love, when they get It?

Parables to an American would not use the same terminology that a parable in Greek, Gaelic, Spanish, Italian, Arabic, Hebrew, or any other language would use. It is time the Americans wake up to What they've got, and see It for what It is worth so they can use It for how God intended It to be used: to save their Souls."

“A SIGNAL THAT SHOUTS”

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“What is a heretic? This term is hushed in our day. It is a term people feel has a tremendous accusation in, and it is a term that so many people fear.

Heretics are a dime a dozen in our time of life, but are not referred to as heretics. Many of these bear the title of theologians, some scholars, some authority in Holy Mother Church. In many areas, Holy Mother Church is being brutally attacked for its traditionalism, its decency, its dignity, its integrity, its honor. WHY SUCH AN ATTACK!!

When something is sound, moral, good, beneficial, and bears in its very essence a ‘truth that is

unquestionable', why do men fight and prevaricate, making fact fiction, truth untruth, and stability a weak stand or understanding?

Holy Mother Church was founded by God Himself because there was a necessity for a change in doctrine, there was a necessity for change in moral obligation, and there was a necessary change needed in the established Truths to give more substance to moral beliefs and moral undertakings, plus moral responsibilities.

Christianity was a necessity, not just a whim. Christianity was based on the value, the standards, and the formula that God Himself felt would re-establish a sound direction for men to undertake, for the good of his or her own Soul.

There is definitely a war going on, but too few men are wise enough to see it, to recognize it, or respond to it. Men are ignoring the obvious war because it will take a great strength to fight it, and to win it. It can be described as good fighting evil, truth fighting untruth, moral fighting immoral, justice fighting injustice, purity fighting impurity, love fighting

hate. A war such as this is called ‘a religious war’, but too few men want to use these words in an open way, because these words are harsh words, defiant words, and words that make men recognize what they are forced to say.

Our Blessed Mother is the Strength we have to fight this great war, and Her Rosary is the greatest Weapon we can use against the evil that is the opposing force.

In many ways the rockets have been seen by so many. Roman Catholics have ignored the rockets that are screaming **SOS, HELP, DANGER, DISASTER, and MAYDAY.** It is appalling to see Roman Catholics act like ostriches hiding their heads in the sand, rejecting responsibilities and opposing the Truth that can be fought for, in a manner that only the Holy Rosary can do.”

“Even with all the emphasis on evangelism, there is a tremendous Spiritual void throughout the whole world. There’s a feeling of emptiness. There is a feeling of something lacking in everyone’s Spiritual activities and Spiritual growth. There is no other explanation for this void than to describe it as a lack of sound doctrine, a lack of truths, and a lack of wisdom in what is being taught by so many self-made prophets and evangelists.

The lack of these things causes a lack of motivation, a lack of stimulation, and a lack of Faith in God. There is so much emphasis on humanism that it automatically avoids dependence upon God and resists even discussing the Purpose for life, Sainthood.

Human emotions, human senses, human involvement, human happiness, human satisfaction of desires, human needs, human understanding, human counsel, belief in human capabilities superseding other beliefs, are all

diminishing the reality of God's Pure and Real Existence.

Men have fallen into so many traps of immorality that they find it normal for their way of life. If this paganistic trait does not end, God's Justice will have to take a stand."

“I WILL — I WILL NOT”

“Both of these terms of decision reflect many moods, ideas, reasons, attitudes, personal opinions, and numerous other thoughts, words and actions of an individual.

Sometimes these words are said in defiance, belligerence, dominance, antagonism, revenge, and/or hate. Other times they are said in commitment to something good. They portray a resolution to solve a particular thing. They determine that the responsibility or an obligation will be solved, or resolved.

These statements of fact are said thousands of times every day, and many times they can be termed ‘vows’ that do not easily release the commitment, making these words important to the lives of individuals.

There are religious vows, there are marriage vows, there are vows in the courts of law that when these words are sworn to on a Bible, they are binding.

These are not just words, and yet people use these words loosely, commonly, indifferently, emotionally, falsely, selfishly. They are rarely used *too* prudently.

The next time you say, ‘I will,’ or ‘I will not,’ remember *how much* these words mean, what they reflect, what you intend to accomplish by them, what responsibility you are accepting, or what you are in disagreement with, and what results will come from your saying these words. Many promises are abused and even broken by these two very simple statements. These are not words to be casually tossed around.”

“TIMELESS”

“Clothing has changed, furniture has changed, housing has changed, and man’s mode of travel has changed, plus there have been many more such physical changes since time began. As these changes take place, I do not change, and what I give to man as My Way, My Rules, My Lessons, are for all men. Also, the calendar is not the method men can use to eradicate or diminish what I have given.

I Am Forever, I Am Eternal, I Have Always Been, I Am The Controller, and I Am The Light of the whole world. My Words cannot die, They cannot be cast aside, and They cannot be for just one man and not another, because everything I have given man is for the benefit of all men.

My Ten Commandments were passed on through a man. His name was ‘Moses’. Moses was an educated man in his time. He was reared in an atmosphere of wealth and power. He was loved, not hated. He was destined to lead people and he had the

background to do it. This was all in My Plan for what I was going to use Moses for. My Plans for Moses were far superior to any man's plans for Moses.

In This *Miracle Of The Beloved Joseph*, I Speak, I Direct, I Teach for not just today, but for all time hereafter. Many of the things I am teaching now, I have taught before. “SOUND REASON WILL CONQUER”

“The slime of immorality is scattered throughout the world. Its inception was caused by human beings allowing, accepting, participating in and perpetuating everything that is against God, His Ten Commandments and the Church He Established, Instituted and left for the whole world to follow His Will for the sake of each man’s Soul. Immorality has no boundaries. There is no place in the world immune to it or safe from it.

At the moment of conception of every human being there is a Soul, a Guardian Angel, and a will to support the Purpose of the physical life for the reason God intended.

The very intellect of man is a *direct affirmation* that man was born to a higher degree of reasoning, understanding and goal.

Man’s innate thirst and hunger to learn more and to learn much from other men confirms the intellect and will that men have.

The innate feeling in man that shows through his feelings of sadness, remorse, fear, apprehension, concern, emotions, compassion, and quiet or expressive desire to survive against all odds, supports and clarifies man's ability of expression, dignifies the human conscience as recognizing sensitivity to good or bad, right or wrong, protecting the physical, mental and Spiritual through the awareness of all that it touches.

So many times it is difficult to be totally aware of things that are happening that are not obviously wrong because they are *surrounded with a facade of justification and colored with benefits*. The justification and the benefits cannot always be identified with *sound values and sound standards or sound reasoning*, but the false justification evolves from the potential nature of the credibility. Many times justification shines so bright, covering what is wrong, because the justification is pleasing, advantageous, or more comfortable, more palatable to one's way of life, one's interest, one's weaknesses, one's lack of strong sound values and standards.

False justification is sometimes the expression of a madman, just to satisfy his own emotions, own lack of sound behavioral coordination. Many times justification is not always just, nor does it ever justify impure, immoral, indecent action of any kind.

In the time we live, we are much victimized and mainly victimized by the facade of *timely change* that preempts any traditional values or logical concerns.

When we think of the world from a viewpoint of picturing the land, the water, the desert, the mountain area, we tend to see just that, and we do not allow ourselves to look at the reality of what exists in these particular places. From the viewpoint of standing in one country and looking at other countries, we evaluate their worth and their existence by what we have learned about them. We form opinions, and our prognosis is that we are not affected by their faults because we are over here and they are over there, so we eliminate any real concern that they might be having an objectionable effect on us.

We read that drugs are brought in from different places. We dismiss it because we do not feel involved. There are numerous ways in which we are affected by the immoralities, the standards and values of other countries, and especially since the world has become so close in communication, and distance so easily accessible to us.

You cannot say that Communism in Russia does not affect you; it does. You cannot say the drug market from any place does not affect you; it does. You cannot say that medical science from other countries does not affect you; it does. You cannot say living where you live is totally out of contact with the thinking, practices or social changes of another country, because you are affected by their fads, sports, household items, sciences, food recipes, and clothing. These have tremendous effects on our life in respect to other countries.

Holy Mother Church has always been universal. Holy Mother Church has always dealt with men of all countries, and Holy Mother Church has stood out as the leader because of Its stability, Its values, Its standards,

Its strength, and of course, Its truths that are the basis of all of this.

We now live in a web, in an entanglement, in a chaotic wave of discrepancies due to depending upon human values, human standards, human ideals, human evaluations, human opinions, humanism in imitation, humanism in the weak term of ‘normal for our time’.

Let’s see things realistically and not submit to imitation, temptation, false leadership, or any unreasonable, irresponsible, immoral acts against God.”

**“WORDS OF WORTH
WORTHY FOR RECOGNITION”**

“Privilege, responsibility, obligation, dedication, commitment, a vow, an oath — each of these has an effect on our life, for each of these, from privilege to oath demands the action of our will for a specific reason, for a particular situation or cause. Each of these bears a particular concern in how we handle one or several of them.

Privileges have many aspects to them and they are binding in many ways. A privilege does not mean freedom. It can mean permission, it can denote a special situation, reason or favor. With each privilege there is responsibility, depending on circumstances, people involved, and reason.

Faith in God is a privilege, has responsibility, bears obligation to specific rules and regulations commanded by God through His Ten Commandments, and through His Church He established for the benefit of our Souls.

Privilege involves dedication, because through the very act of a privilege there must be a certain amount of dedication so that the privilege is never abused.

Privilege encourages commitment, because commitment in many ways encourages understanding, gratefulness and thanks for the privilege offered and accepted. It is a privilege to take a vow when the vow is for the good, for the welfare, or for the intention of a sound moral act of life, for life, in life.

There is privilege in an oath, for in the oath there is dignity that bespeaks a responsible human being is taking an oath of allegiance, of commitment, of dedication, and values the responsibility that the oath promises is truth.

These are all words we think about, and we rarely see as words we must be aware of in our own life, in our own actions, and in our own realm of usage.”

“ANSWERS TOO!”

“Of course there are answers to these questions, and answers that dignify the beauty of a religious vocation.

- 1. All people, the young, middle-aged and older should never lose**

sight of the beauty to serve God as an individual, in a life of total dedication and commitment for the benefit of the physical being, the mental health, and the Spiritual Holiness of themselves and all other people.

2. Sound religious vocations cannot be obsolete because God is Eternal and we are never without Him. His continuous Existence in our life through the air we breathe, our constant awareness of His Gift of Faith to us, and His Church in which He left for us The Holy Communion of Him with us, His children, cannot be cast aside, erased or forgotten. The *indelible proof* of His Presence is more than our Faith, it is our reasoning, our intellect, and our Soul's constant closeness with God.

3. In such a total commitment in a religious vocation of life, it is necessary for sound leadership and sound Spiritual authority to be the absolute formula for others to follow, desiring Holiness for themselves and to work at being this example to others.

Such devoted leadership and authority is not evident in these

times, but we must begin to ask God to allow this to happen because of its magnificent purpose and the beauty of its soundness in serving Him in the physical life.

Example of happiness in serving God is one of the greatest encouragements to others to want to follow in this path of life.

4. **An ideal religious vocation is to be living physically, emotionally, morally, mentally and spiritually, totally involved in wanting to please God above all things, and totally aware of what such service to God means to Him, means to one's Soul, and means to all people throughout the world.**

Happiness in a religious vocation shouts stability, honor, dignity, and a love for The Divine that rings with a purity of mind, body and Soul. Happiness that radiates from one who serves in a religious vocation humbly, and yet revealing a tremendous strength that recognizes the privilege of such a life, should show to everyone that as God put His Blessing upon the married state with the privilege of procreation, companionship, and service in many areas of life, that The

Son also showed the beauty of the single life in service to The Father. He also showed in this manner of life the beauty of sacrifice, the purpose for example, and the greatness in selflessness and in a lack of selfishness that could give example to man beyond what anything else could.

Sometimes it is important for particular individuals to bind themselves to a religious vocation because it is the soundest way for them to reach Sainthood. In many of these cases, to accept another way of life, though they would live it with the necessary sharing and acceptance of the responsibilities attached to it, they would also be more likely to find temptation more readily and perhaps even be more vulnerable to impure actions.

It is difficult to tell someone which vocation they should follow, for the will of each individual, the nature, the personality, the desires, the dreams, the hopes, the aspirations, the ambitions, are individual to each person, and a lifelong vocation must be arrived at through the individual's own will and own strength of commitment.

Religious vocations are not absolute promises to Sainthood, but it is a beautiful vocation of life that God has shown Great Love for, and Great Direction to, giving man a choice to serve Him in a particular way to arrive at Sainthood.

If man would only look logically, seriously, openly, at all the paths God has given to man, man would never have an excuse to not serve God and to not become a Saint.”

The urge for so many to want to expound to others on how to *save* one’s self, in many ways is a parallel to so many times in History when men and women were honoring false gods, acting in idolatry to something they could touch, something they could visibly see, something they could respond to.

When men hold hands in prayer to God, it is an emotional experience, and encourages sensitivity to human relationship; plus, it produces a dependence upon other men, rather than strengthening the stability of standing on one’s own merits, own strengths, on one’s own Faith to grow spiritually and serve God with one’s own free will.

In holding hands in prayer, men can only be as strong as the chain of touch allows. What happens when there is a break in the chain, or a link is gone?”

“PRAYER IS IMPORTANT”

“Prayer is our manner, form, method, means and understanding of a verbal communication with God.

We must never omit prayer from our daily life. Even though our actions, thoughts and deeds are always to be His Way and according to His Will, our prayers in His Direction are our direct communication for our personal attention to His Existence and to His being our God, our Judge, our Creator, our Hope.

Prayer can be short, long, or just ejaculations such as ‘*I love You, God,*’ ‘*Thank You, God,*’ ‘*Please stay close to me, God.*’

Prayer is important for it speaks our inner feeling to God and allows us to say personal things to Him that are between just God and us.

Never forget the beauty, the privilege or the necessity for this wonderful *Gift of Faith* that gives us strength, hope, peace of mind, and encouragement to go on and do things

we might never have the courage or incentive to do.

Prayer is a Godsend, so return the love, and send your prayers to God. Deliver them yourself.

The sad part about people in their prayer life is that they approach prayer with little Faith and understanding of the Miracle of Love that God is. They forget that His Presence, though not seen, is more present and understandable than someone who is talking, singing, or moving about.

The very Presence of God is evident in our very existence and in the Ultimate Control of the universe, plus the magnificence of the very design of man in relation to other things, plus the intellect of man that is constantly evident every moment of every day.

God is Real and should be seen as a Real Being that is Superior and Ultimate, and it is not necessary to see Him with the physical eye, only to have the Faith to feel His Presence at all times.”

“ARTIFICIAL BREEDS FACADE”

“We live in an immoral, social world. Many men, in their striving to live a life of involvement and be socially acceptable to other people, use an abnormalcy, a sophistication creating a false image, a false personality, and a false set of standards. Sophistication is not the answer to being socially successful, nor is the answer degeneracy based on immorality of all sorts.

The guidelines for most people in these years has been to be equal in status financially, morally, emotionally, mentally, and even spiritually. Men have become so status conscious that they have lost sight of the sound basic values that set a status quo for living.

The dominant forces for education have been stimulated by a wild influx of using education as a position of control rather than using education as a means of great achievement to fulfill sound standards of living.”

**“THE WILL OF MAN
HIS LINE OF DECISION”**

“The *will* of an individual has much responsibility to God, and to all mankind.

A strong *will* is good when it acts only for good, but when the *will* of an individual expresses a *willfulness*, it can be an ugly situation or relationship, because of stubbornness, wanting one’s own way, doing mean or unkind things on purpose, displaying only selfishness, immaturity, foolishness, even bigotry.

When you *take a good look* at your *will*, be sure that all results that you intend to reach are for the good of all concerned.”

“MUMBLERS”

“Mumblers have a motive of deceit, lies, and covering up the real thing.

People are not born mumblers. They adopt this form of communication so they won't be understood and people can't pin them down to decisions or commitments.

Mumblers are annoying, disrespectful, insincere, insecure individuals who never truly enjoy life because they are too busy covering up their intentions, real feelings, what they have done or are doing, thus feeling that people won't expect anything from them, so they won't have to produce.

If you know a mumblor, there is no quick cure, but there are some methods that force them out in the open. One is, don't anticipate their needs, make them show good signs for the needs. Second, don't cater to their mumbling by wearing yourself out trying to fit the sounds with the

situation. Third, don't yell in anger at them, but talk so softly they can't hear you.

This subject and solution is very important. It is necessary to stand up and be counted mentally, physically and spiritually, and if we do not see our moral obligation regarding the mumblers in our society, we will waste our time on them and spend less time on worthwhile projects, people, and good example for others who need our time and example.

Mumblers have undue, unjustifiable tempers. This is sinful and should not be catered to. The world today is overrun with mumblers. Don't support them.

Mumblers can cause such irritating situations and relationships that the anger derived from these times causes offenses against God and sets a mood of retaliation, impure thoughts, words and actions.

If you are a mumbler, STOP IT."

“The piranhas don’t always stay at the bottom of the water. They sometimes come to the surface and are as deadly at the surface as they are in deep water.

Let us look at this image of protectiveness, contentedness, relationship, and act of love that is obvious through this setting. There is more being said than the natural emphasizes in this matter. The very protective strength of Saint Joseph carrying Jesus in His Arms says that to carry The Son of God, one must be God. What mortal could be so entrusted with such a Treasured Son?

To look further into the magnificence of this gesture immediately says that the Protector of this Child is more, and His Image that is projected in protection, care

and love, was truly meant as God holding mankind as children in His Arms, protecting them with all of the necessary strength, hopes, loves, and necessities of life.

Through this Image we must better understand the Dignity that was portrayed by Saint Joseph as man. The Example was for all men to better understand the privileged role of being man and the privileged role of being the father of a family, protecting, providing, caring, with the discipline of God's Love in this role.

Men must emulate what this Image depicts so that through the imitation of how God meant men to be, men will see the beauty of manhood, the strength of manhood, the duties of manhood, and the goal for which manhood was created."

“SCANDAL IS ‘NEVER’ NECESSARY”

“Scandal is not just in the news media. Scandal is the result of impure, improper actions against the decency of another person’s name or reputation.

Scandal is more common than people care to think. It is the obscene lack of respect for the moral values and standards that are God’s Will for man, emanating from immodesty and/or blasphemous accusations against the reputation or personal life of someone.

Scandal is abusive to not just the dignity of an individual, but to the intellect, the Spiritual values, beliefs and standards of someone, plus the derogatory accusations, intentions or liable inferences that encourage a vile contempt for the moral structure of an individual.

Scandal is a sinful process of degradation and debases the moral values and standards of an individual,

belittling the decency of their moral behavior that God intended for them.

Scandal is evident at all ages. Are you a scandalmonger? Do you thrive on scandal? Does scandal give you a feeling of being informed, a feeling of an inside look into the private life of someone else? If so, it would be wise to find a more sound, healthy means of entertainment, of interest, of satisfaction. To find pleasure at the expense of other people, not just suggests, but definitely shows instability in one's personal opinion of one's self, and also shows a lack of integrity, a lack of dignity and a lack of moral values.

Scandal can be a treacherous affront to the victim's life, family, work and social acceptance. Don't buy scandal sheets, information or conversation. To read it, to listen to it, to pass it on can mark your Soul with serious offenses against God.

Turn your thinking, your interests to more positive worthwhile entertainment, hobbies, and time-consuming productive projects.

Don't dismiss this subject from your conscience. You are surrounded

by it, and it will take a positive stand from you to walk away from it in every way you are touched by it.”

“ADMIT THE TRUTH”

“A daily *examination of conscience* is limited in a truly conscientious look at our offenses against God.

Most times one’s bad habits that are offensive are overlooked by one’s conscience, because one’s daily habits are taken for granted as normal acts, normal thoughts, normal words or normal deeds connected to one’s nature, personality, environment, and dealings with other people.

One’s *examination of conscience* is more apt to cover only the things that occurred, leaving an indelible impression that they are out of the realm of an ordinary, natural or acceptable way of living. So as we take another look at *our conscience* when we examine our actions, we must look at ourselves in a realistic course of daily living in our daily search to become a Saint.

Our slightest faults that are irritating to others must be worked on to overcome them. Our slightest

impure thoughts or actions must be seen by us as a necessary thing to change for the good of our Soul. We must question ourselves about our language imperfections, our intentions in why we do things, and when we perform an act of charity, is it pure charity or false charity?

In examining our conscience we should evaluate our part of all we took part in that day, for in just examining one's conscience we could easily eliminate what displeased others and only think about what displeased us, thus justify any unkind or undue retaliation from us to someone else, or any unkind act we made in someone else's direction.

Let's look at our faults that are offensive first to God, and to our fellowman. Let's recognize these faults as irritating to others, misleading to others, poor example to others, or even using others for the benefit of selfish motives for ourselves.

We must always remember that an examination of our personal habits, intentions we take for granted, our language that has become a natural course of speech, our modesty that we

abuse by accepting immodesty as our code of behavior, and/or our indiscreet manners that we accept as personal and above reproach, supersedes an *examination of conscience* when we sincerely want to act in a more pure state of being for the good of our Soul.”

“LOGIC IS SPELLED OUT”

“What is a Soul? A Soul is a Portion of God, a Part of God.

What is the importance of the Soul? Why is the Soul so important? The Soul is of extreme Importance because the Soul, being a Portion of God, a Part of His Being, it is necessary for this Soul to be returned to God in a ‘Glorified State’ that resulted from a human being serving God in a ‘pure state’, returning the Soul to God as a Saint.

God, in His Pure Love, His Ultimate Generous Divine Charity, made man for the Purpose that man would share Heaven with Him. The logic that a mortal man could not exist in Heaven made it necessary for God to place a Part of Himself into the creation of each man, thus making it possible for man to enter the Kingdom of Heaven for All Eternity. It is also logical to believe and to understand that it would then be This Portion of human life that would remain after the physical no longer existed. This

Portion, This Part of God is called ‘the Soul’.

A Soul, as a Part of God, is a Divine Living Entity of man, to man. This Soul, because It is a Part of God, must return to Him in the manner and in the way God decreed It should be. The very design of man, created to the Image and Likeness of God, showing the Ultimate Purpose for man in God’s Creation, plus the intellect of man in relation to the Wisdom of God, plus the fact that man has Faith in God, proves that man has a direct communication with God, and it is sheer logic to understand this Communication, this Connection as ‘the Soul’.

It is more than Faith in God that assures man that he has a Soul. It is the innate understanding that God’s Act of Love to man was Special and is Special, for Its very existence dignifies man’s existence, and permits man to walk a specific, special path for personal gain.

The intellect, the logic, and the Faith in God that man has been instilled with, says the gain for man and the Goal for this gain is Sainthood for the Soul of man. The Soul becoming

a Saint bears the identity of the man who served God for this Purpose. No other creation of God's has this Gift, this Blessing, this Promise.

God's Ten Commandments proved His Love and His Purpose for each man's life. God's Ten Commandments are more than Rules and Commands. They are a complete Instruction, a complete Direction for man's behavior in his physical, mental and moral ethics.

The Ten Commandments are not just Guidelines, but in Their very essence are a total and complete map of what paths, what directions, what intentions, should be seen as the flawless, pure way to Sainthood.

God's Ten Commandments are an Ultimate Gift from God based on moral standards and moral values, with the intention totally for a pure state of being, in spite of all the temptations man may have, in spite of all the problems men may have to face, in spite of all the chaos, the disaster and the turbulence caused by God's enemy, and man's enemy, satan.

God's Ten Commandments are the armor, are the fortresses of Stability,

Faith, Purity, and Hope. Any man who abides by God's Ten Commandments, holds These Commandments as the Direction in all moral values and all moral standards, has no direction to go other than to become a Saint.

The establishment and institution of Holy Mother Church once again proved God's Love for mankind. God's Motives in this additional Gift, Holy Mother Church, was to supplement His Ten Commandments. This time He gave to mankind Another Portion, Another Part of Himself so that man would be left with a Physical Means to support his Faith in God and his Purpose for life: to become a Saint.

God's Love is no mystery. God's Intention for man is no mystery. Man's Faith in God proves there is a God, for if there was no God there would be no need for Faith in God. God does not waste time or energy on ridiculous, unimportant acts or actions. This tendency is totally man's nature and personality."

“RUNNING”

“Running for physical exercise or running because it is necessary to escape from a situation or running in a race, makes running reasonable, understandable and practical.

Running from sound direction in sound religious beliefs eliminates logical behavior and points to irresponsibility, irreverence, irrational behavior.

Justification of dismissing the Ten Commandments from one’s life gives an unrealistic value to all rational laws of government, or society, because these were all based on the Ten Commandments.

How can people follow a satanic movement, accepting all that is evil, eliminating all that is good? What is the basis for such irrational behavior? Some people say such a movement is not that serious in the world. These people are uninformed, but they are also like ostriches because *they do not*

***want to face* the sound reality of what is really happening in the world.**

All of the immorality that is expressed openly and with great fervor is proof of a demonic pressure in the world. People *run* because they do not feel they want to stand up for what is right. It takes too much time, too much energy, too much strength, too much perseverance, too much integrity, and it forces them to be ethical. When people fight being ethical, fight being truthful, they are supporting a lesser code of ethics, code of culture, code of religious beliefs.

People *run* for many reasons, and in the *running* there can be great chain reaction caused, because of the sensitivity of man to man. The next time you *run* away from what you know is truth, sound Faith in God, bear in mind that God must be first in your thoughts, in your love, in your direction, in your goals.”

“PIETY”

“There is a mistaken idea about piety. Piety is defined very simply as Reverence for God, devotion to religion. Both of these things are outward expressions of Hope and of Faith in God.

It is difficult to see piety in today’s evangelism that is so dominant in the world. Evangelism today bears a strong mark of self-love, self-esteem, self-performance, self-righteousness, self-perfection, false prophecy, false idealism, false interpretation, false translation, omitting the beauty of piety in its true essence.

When you kneel quietly before The Blessed Sacrament, it should be in an act of solemn dignified Reverence to God because of Who God Is. Piety is expressed through our prayers, in our repetitiveness of our prayers, in our devotion to our prayers, and our Spiritual exercises and ceremonies that honor God in special ways.

Piety is not a thing of the past because Reverence for God should never be a thing of the past. It is time that people begin to return piety to their way of life and remember what piety means in its content, in its reason, and in its practice.”

“CHOOSING GOD ‘IS’ NORMAL”

“A constant remark made by millions of people throughout time has been, ‘I want to feel close to God, *but* I also want to live a normal life.’

Sound logic says the *but* is a ridiculous connecting word. It also says that the emphasis on the *but* falsely identifies normal living to a totally *opposite relationship* from closeness to God.

In the total Creation of man, God did not separate man from Him. This should help men to understand that to live a normal, full, happy life, means a *close relationship* with God continuously, constantly. The only time man separates himself from normal to abnormal is when he himself indulges in all that is against God.

The next time you say to yourself or to anyone else, ‘I want to live a full life, I want to do it the right way; I want God in my mind, in my works, in my words, in my thoughts, in my actions, in my deeds, so that my life

will be fulfilled according to His Will for me,' then you will live a life of normalcy, of reality, of fulfillment."

**“SAINTHOOD IS IN
EVERYONE’S REACH”**

“The *special* determination of an individual person to do the Will of God is not limited to any *one* or *small group* of people. It is the privilege of all human beings.

The *perseverance* of doing God’s Will, for The Saints, was the key to their Sainthood. Their various methods, means, intentions, motives, sacrifices, acts of charity, acceptance of responsibilities, strength in standing up for the truths they believed in and fought for, and through their dauntless efforts to achieve special goals to accomplish a status of leading others in piety and more love for God, made their lives outstanding example for everyone.

Firm beliefs in strict self-discipline for the benefit of one’s Soul are obviously necessary for a life of commitment and dedication to do God’s Will. A watered down version, a *halfhearted* attempt or approach at devoting one’s life to God’s Will

for the Soul is nothing more than an excuse for one's lack of self-control, lack of self-discipline, ignoring the full understanding of the Meaning and Purpose for the physical life, and even though endowed with Spiritual Faith *in* God, ignoring the Gift of Faith *from* God.

The *intellect* of man tells him that his existence has a substantial Purpose and Meaning. He was not born to decorate the world, he had Purpose. The very *environment* of living has a valuable lesson in the Importance of man's life.

The *design of man* and his sensitive nature to climate, to eating, to the desire and need for shelter, his initiative, his ability to reason, to make decisions, to accomplish so many things, his innate sense of right and wrong to rules and moral values and standards, sets man in a class of distinction different than all other living things.

Sainthood is not a competitive proposition among men. It is a result of loving God more than one's self. It is a persevering force of human desires, needs, moral ethics, moral

disciplines, along with a true sense of piety, whether it be silent or verbal.

God beckons, calls, summons all men to Sainthood. Many ignore His Obvious Methods and choose to place more importance on immoral living, thinking they are acting as a free agent, facing each day with only a small glimmer of what life is all about.

A tangled web of detours on the way to Sainthood can be avoided, *but* if selfishness, self-love, self-acclaim, sinfulness, disobedience to God's Commandments are practiced as a mode of life, then Sainthood is not inevitable."

“SHOES HAVE A WAY OF TALKING”

“The shoes of a Saint could have been the same size that you wear. They walked in them for the purpose of a life of fulfillment, using sound moral values and sound moral standards, living a life of personal application to Divine Rule and Will, each as an individual acting for a particular cause, for a special reason, facing adversities with a dignity and an integrity, dauntless in their beliefs and Faith in God’s Will.

Today we have this same privilege, to act for the same reasons and for the same purposes as they did. When the last recognized Saint died, all paths to Heaven were not blocked off from the rest of mankind. In each day of living there are many opportunities to face fighting for God’s Will to be done in the world.

The *world* has survived many abominations caused by man to man. The *world* has survived many great wars in which many men’s lives were uselessly taken. The *world* has

survived immoralities of the lowest form encouraged by the enemy of God and of man. But how did the *Souls* survive all these things? Were all human beings in a perfect state of Grace so that there is no question as to the Salvation of their Soul? To some people this is not important as long as they still have a *world* to stand on, a sky to stand beneath, lodging to shelter themselves, and food to eat and drink.

Tomorrow when you awaken and it is time for you to put your shoes on, ask yourself this very important question: Would you be proud to hand your shoes to someone else; that is, in the sense that to follow in your shoes they would imitate all you have done, using you as the perfect example for the Salvation of their Soul? Would you feel confident that these shoes of yours would be able to show them the path to God?

Think about this. Pick someone you love very much, and in your Will to them, Will them your shoes to follow and to repeat every step you took, every direction you went. Will these shoes lead them to Heaven?"

**“DON’T TRY TO STEAL
A PLACE IN HEAVEN
YOU CAN’T”**

“Don’t believe anyone who tells you that you are *saved* just because you think it, want it, or profess to witness to it.

Emotionalism in *accepting the Lord* does not hold water. It is merely an expression that someone made up and it caught on as a way of saying that now you are going to see Our Lord in a different way than you had been seeing Him, or that your lifestyle would improve. It takes more than an emotional commitment to become dedicated to truth about one’s self, one’s lifestyle and one’s Faith in God, and this manner of commitment doesn’t whitewash everything and correct all flaws in one’s human weaknesses, nature, personality, environment, habits or behavior.

Devotion to God, personal commitment to His Will being done through you, and an inner and outward growth of piety must have a sound,

firm, more realistic foundation than emotional reaction to someone, or what someone might say.

Don't try to fool God by fooling or kidding yourself into believing that God is only *Love*. Love on man's terms many times means *easy mark* or selfish possessiveness of another person. God's Love is Pure and is based on Purity. In this Pure State of Being, there are no tricks, misunderstandings, or imperfect misuse of His Love, so It cannot be compared to man's love or man's unrealistic view of The Perfection God Is, The Purity He Is, The Wisdom He Is or The Perfect Justice He Is.

***Sainthood* is more than *accepting the Lord*. It is a downright use of all means of one's intellect, behavior, nature, personality, and logical decisions, with God's Will in mind at all times.**

Stop diminishing God by putting Him on a level with man. God is God and beyond any human ability to comprehend. He must be honored, revered, and our Faith in Him must be solid, respected and respectful; plus, we must never carelessly refer to Him

so as to blaspheme Him or His Name. Any sacrilegious action toward God should be stopped immediately.”

“YOU HAVE A CHOICE”

“The Godlessness of a condemned Soul would be the ultimate of suffering for All Eternity.

The *darkness* of Hell that is total hopelessness, along with the *monotony* of continual darkness would be the horrors of the damned. Any additional condition such as continual *harassment* from the devil, the demons and other lost Souls would be more horrible than we could ever imagine. A wise man would not choose Hell, but work diligently to become a Saint.

Sainthood is God’s Will for the Soul, and man’s human will has the privilege to daily make the decisions that will assure his or her Soul of Sainthood.

First, by living in constant obedience to the Ten Commandments.

Second, by utilizing one’s Faith in God in every thought, word, deed and action, through practicing virtues, developing in piety, and imitating The Saints.

Third, being good example at all times.”

“NEVER GAMBLE WITH YOUR SOUL”

“Remember your Soul is a Portion of God.

When you walk into a gambling facility, you have the privilege to gamble but you have no *rights*. Only the establishment has rights. Satan offers *privileges* and you *forfeit* your rights when you gamble *with* him, or *on* him. Don't gamble with your Soul as the *stake* in a strictly win or lose situation. In all types of gambling, the odds are *always* against you. Never forget, Holy Communion gives you the privilege to receive God in a physical way to nourish your body, mind and Soul every day. There is no gamble to this Act of Love.

Men today are gambling with their Souls, using It as the collateral for a possible bit of excitement through the briar patches of foulness in all relationships, false idolatry of human desires, weaknesses, humanism, thus eliminating Godliness, performing blasphemous acts against God, partaking in impure actions that

control their daily existence, based on total disobedience to God's Ten Commandments.

OR
“THE HAZARDS OF IMMORALITY”**

“Immorality is a word that many people refuse to accept as the conditions under which or by which they live each day. Immorality in its very word says disobedience to God’s Ten Commandments. The world today is in a frivolous whirl, and can be termed ‘a terrible time of lewd obscenities based on total immorality’.

Why has *immodesty* become so acceptable in every area of life: immodest clothing, immodest living conditions, immodest reading material, immodest language, immodesty in cultural standards leading to total immorality, with no consideration for the dignity of man, or for the responsibility man has for his behavior to be above that of an animal?

Many times immodesty is the first step to immorality, and many times immodesty is difficult at first, but then becomes habitual in its practice. Children at very young ages

should be taught modesty, and be made aware that immodesty is wrong and is against God's Will.

Any argument defending immodesty has a tremendous weakness in it based only on theory, opinion, and a lack of Faith in God's Way of doing things or how God expects things to be done. Immodesty is crude, offensive, and improper, indecent, vulgar, coarse, imprudent, impudent and forward. Immodesty does not express relaxation, but oftentimes in its very existence, creates and causes a painful relationship to many other people."

“Defense of the Faith can only be done by those who have sincere true Faith.

Defending the Faith is a positive stand *against* all wrong actions or untrue directions and false teachings of individuals or groups of people, who jeopardize the value and standards of the sound doctrine, dogma, and Spiritual devotions and practices God intended, established, and instituted in Holy Mother Church.”

“A man who says there is no God is a victim of his own blindness caused by his own insecurity in his inability to recognize the Supremacy of Someone in an All Powerful State of Being. This insecurity is based on his fears, ego, and his submission to a totally humanistic, limited unreality of the Purpose of life.”

SEPTEMBER 9, 1981

“There was one day on a trip that I was very ill, and I felt, as I sat on the edge of the bed, a great yoke around my chest and over my shoulders, and it was a weight that I could not describe. At the time it became so heavy I wanted to cry, and I asked God to take it off because, ‘It’s too heavy, God, I can’t stand it anymore.’

About two hours later as I was laying in bed I was told that the yoke had to be and it could never be taken off until much was accomplished according to His Will. I found myself saying: ‘They are not listening, God. You have spoken so many times and in so many ways, and my tiredness makes me want to rest and not talk.’ He said: ‘The yoke is My Love for mankind. The yoke is to assure mankind of your service to Me. The yoke is placed there so you will always remember there is work to be done, service to be rendered, and children to be taught.’

I asked Him what the yoke looked like, for I said: ‘My shoulders seem

bent under it. I feel as though my body cannot stand up under the pressure or the weight.' He said, 'The yoke crosses the shoulders like a strap, and the strap in the front and the strap in the back is to guide every movement.' He said without the yoke, men would try to get me to go their way. He said: 'The yoke is more than a reminder. The yoke has become very heavy because of man's lack of change.'

I said, 'What is the inscription on the yoke?' and at this He smiled and He said, 'Service and obedience without question, dedication and commitment to My Will without faltering.' I said, 'There seems to be more written on the yoke.' He said: 'It is written in many languages for many people. It is written in many ways for children of all kind.'

I asked Him the color of the yoke and He smiled and He said, 'The color can only be described thusly: It is a brilliant Light blinding to the eye of mankind, but,' He said, 'in this Light there is Wisdom, Hope, Love, Mercy and Justice for all men who desire to see the yoke, who desire to understand the yoke, and who desire to share the

yoke of such commitment to Divine Will.'

I asked Him another question: 'Will You ever release the yoke?' He said, 'I will release the yoke when My Will is accomplished upon the earth.'

As the story unfolded to me, there was much more detail, but the more I understood the necessity for this yoke, the more responsibility I felt for taking care of the yoke.

I asked Him another question: 'Will men ever understand the value of their Faith in You? Will men ever stop listening to satan?' He smiled again and He said: 'Use a firm hand for unless you do, the weight of the yoke will be more than you can stand. Men must begin to see the value of obedience to Me, the necessity for reaching for purity. Men must become more pious, more respectful.

'A long time ago I gave the world a Miracle, a Miracle of Truth, Honor, Dignity and Hope. And in the Teachings that I gave, I gave mankind Direction to live by and to grow in more hope for All Eternity. They have allowed distractions to enter in, and in many ways now men have a

hopelessness within them, for they are torn between the right and the wrong, the good and the evil. Men are listless and men are restless, for they feel if they follow the Light of Divine Will they will miss out on life and they will forfeit joy and happiness.

‘I have given mankind Hope in All the Words that I have spoken and in All the Words and Directions I have allowed The Saints to speak.

‘The yoke is a yoke of honor, as was the armor of the knights of old. Their armor was extremely heavy and they wore it with honor, to protect their body, but also to show they were warriors for a particular cause.’

He said: ‘Tell My daughters and tell My sons who respect what they have been given, that when they wear their “Yoke of Atonement”¹ and their

¹ The “Yoke of Atonement” is a specially designed Scapular worn over the shoulders by the members of The Society Of The Little Way, as an outward expression of commitment and dedication to practice virtues in imitation of “The Little Way of Saint Therese of Lisieux”.

“Shield of Honor”,² they must know there is much responsibility when such a piece of armor shows. And when they take it off, what it stands for may be out of sight, but they must always keep it in mind that as I look at them I see the Yoke of Atonement and the Shield on them.

‘And so it is with you, My daughter, the yoke you wear, different in size and proportion, in design and color, but those who love Me wear a yoke, wear the yoke of a warrior, for the Soul to return to Me.’

Be blessed, My children, for what I have spoken is fact. What I have given to you in Words is for you to better understand that the outward appearance of what you have accepted to wear makes others recognize you and makes them know that you truly care.

² The “Shield of Honor” worn by the men in The Society Of Saint John Vianney is an outward sign saying that as the Shield is worn it is to defend and protect Holy Mother Church, the vocation of the Priesthood, and the Faith upon which Holy Mother Church was founded.

The time in the world is serious, and men are walking away from The Father's Will and they are walking into the briar patches, trying to experience thrills.

The time has come and you must know that you must be committed and dedicated to only obey The Father's Will. And remember, My children, that though your eyes cannot see all things, My Eyes are aware of all children, all Souls, all things, not just in the world but throughout the whole universe. Show your Faith in a respectful way. Show your love for Divine Will in your obedience to the Ten Commandments, and respond to the Light with piety, trust, honor, dignity and hope. So be it."

“THE HOUSE OF GOD”

“When we think of Church, we think of a place that we can go into and find peace, solitude, hope, and a sense of the Presence of God. We do not go into the Church saying to ourselves we will have a vision and God will speak to us. Our innocent Faith tells us that He is Present in this place, and that as we stand in His Presence, He is aware of us, and we can speak to Him with no interference of other men hearing or other men even guessing what we are saying. It is not a feeling of secrecy, but a feeling of intimacy with God Who created us.

When there is turmoil in the administrative areas of the Church between men who decree and enforce their interpretation of their understandings on particular issues, their actions sometimes turn the Church into an *arena* whereby the flock, the body of the Church, become spectators and victims of the holocaust that is a destructive undercurrent of false piety, false beliefs, false understanding, and false

exaggerations, plus a dominance of authority that is biased with self-esteem.

In some places and some times, Holy Mass has become an arena of disrespect to God, to man, to the faithful, attacking the orthodox beliefs of so many Roman Catholics.

Pettiness is not the way to Sainthood, nor is bickering, dickering or abusive innuendos; plus, such disrespectful shows of *Jesus Christ Superstar* and *Godspell* plays on a paganistic atmosphere, and are sacrilegious when they portray the life of The Son of God in such carnival displays, disregarding the Importance and Meaning for which Holy Mass was established and instituted for the Salvation of our Souls.

A formal protocol should be established for all times that we have the privilege to enter God's House on earth. This holds for the clergy as well as the laity.

At all times there should be a dignified reverence demanding that everyone uphold the respect due to this important place upon earth. People should understand that God's

House must be treated as the privilege it is, and that rules should be carried out showing dignity, respect, honor, reverence due such a special place.

Some of the demands of protocol should be spelled out and then someone there to carry them out so they will become common practice, replacing the carelessness, impudence, disrespect that is being practiced, disregarding the importance of this precious place.

- 1. Upon entering, one should stop talking and make *The Sign of The Cross* as an open act of Faith in respect to the Resident of this House.**
- 2. Bowing in a genuflection, bending a knee in humility to God, The Creator of All Things, should not be something that men do or don't do. It should be a form of positive action with only one exception to this rule, and that is physical disability, and this should be the only reason for it to not be carried out.**

- 3. While in the Presence of God, there should be no chatter, no looking around, no undue gestures of distraction. The focus should be totally on The Blessed Sacrament, whether it be during Holy Mass, during special devotions, or a personal private visit with God.**

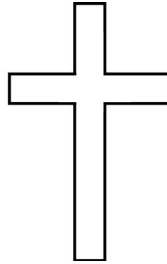
It should be stressed at all times that each Church be spared any chance of vandalism, disrespect, or any indignity practiced.

SACRAMENTS**

“BAPTISM”

“The Sacrament of Baptism is precious to mankind for it is an Act of Consecration to Purity. It is an act of submission to God’s Will through purification. It is a form of commending one’s whole self to the Will of God, to reject satan and all sinful acts, actions or involvements.

When Baptism is given to a small child, it is to ensure such purification and it is to assure the child that this Act of Love was acted upon immediately so the child would have the privilege of knowing that it was in the State of Grace through the act of a Great Sacrament beloved by God, and one in which strength would come in the hour of need for the good of the child’s Soul.

As soon as a child is ready to understand cleanliness, a child should be taught about the Baptism he or she had been given, and it should be stressed throughout one’s life by Priests, emphasizing the Importance of this Great Sacred Sacrament.

In the last years men have diminished this Sacrament by their

lack of dignity in performing it, their lack of piety in reference to it, and their changes in preparation for the reception of it. Perhaps they felt it better this way, but it is still the Sacrament of Baptism, and perhaps it should be stressed more about its full meaning, not just before the child is baptized, but during sermons at Mass, during special devotions, and it should be obvious through constant example of sound moral values and sound moral standards expressed by everyone.”

“PENANCE”

“To be alert to the necessity of Penance has wisdom, because restitution, retribution, reparation must be the balance for unkindness, indecencies, impurities, and any acts against God’s Ten Commandments.

The treasured Sacrament of Penance should never be dismissed or diminished because it is a constant reminder that we must make amends through retribution for all our offenses against God, and this Sacrament should be constantly in our mind so that we do not stray into the briar patches and become so involved in struggling to release ourselves that we omit or bypass the advantage or the opportunity to prepare ourselves for the Sacrament of Penance, partaking in its availability, reminding us of the necessity for purification of our Soul for our entrance into Heaven.”

“HOLY COMMUNION”

“The reception of Holy Communion is distinct from all other things in life. Its very exceptional quality should be a treasured moment each time we approach this Sacrament of Divine Love. It is a time of union with God physically, mentally and spiritually embraced with His Love, His Strength, and His Hope that in this union with Him, we will yearn and work for the Goal of Sainthood.”

“CONFIRMATION”

“The Sacrament of Confirmation envelops and involves The Holy Spirit of God, and in receiving this Sacrament we are told that we will grow in Spiritual maturity. This Sacrament should never be avoided if it is at all possible for one to receive it.”

“MATRIMONY”

“The Sacrament of Matrimony should be treated with solemnity and dignity in every aspect of it. The new theory of so-called preparation for this Important Sacrament has many pitfalls in it, and in many cases it has degraded the Sacrament before it is performed.

Many couples are subjected to the ridicule and the immoral banter by a novice or a supposedly well-rounded, or well-versed practicing Catholic who injects a suggestive sensitivity to the supposedly preparatory sessions that the men in the Church are demanding as premarital preparation.

Not a few, but many people who have been exposed to this disgraceful time have left these sessions disheartened by the lack of sound moral values and sound moral standards that took place regarding their contract in marriage. Such immature, imprudent practices should not be allowed.

The Sacred Sacrament of Matrimony is between two people, witnessed by the celebrant, and his place is not as the great interrogator of

their personal problems or situations, but as the witness to their contract that should be done with a solemnity, a purity, and a direction to their piety in this relationship.”

“HOLY ORDERS”

“**T**his vocation is meant to be followed in the footsteps of Jesus Christ. The schooling and practical experience is meant to teach about God, perform the Sacraments, and continuously serve the Spiritual needs of all mankind for the sake of his own Soul, and the Souls of all people he comes in contact with. “This Beautiful Sacrament has been known many times to not just fortify someone who is dying, but has been the cause of the return of health or an improvement in health when it

was exercised in the proper manner for the proper reason.

This Sacrament is special because it gives hope and strength to one's Faith in God in a time of need. The new casualness associated with this Sacrament diminishes its Importance, and of course, the fact that it is not now necessary for a Priest to perform this Sacrament, in many ways defeats its purpose by it not being given by a Priest, because of the strength needed by the patient in knowing that a man who has chosen the Priesthood follows in the footsteps of Christ, thus innately feeling that *Christ uses the Priest* for such an Important Sacrament.

When Our Lord went to Lazarus, there was no doubt that Our Lord's Presence was important, and that just any man visiting Lazarus could not have performed such an Act of Love, nor could any other man have given Mary and Martha the hope they had.

The men in the Church should see themselves in this role of importance where the Faith of a human being is at stake. They should think of the story of Lazarus and not feel important but responsible, and carry out the tasks

that are necessary to give the hope and the strength to the human factor, and to the Soul of the human being when it is needed.”

**“DON’T BECOME A
PART OF THE SCHISM”**

“Don’t fall into the trap of the *schism* that the *American Catholic Church* is introducing, practicing, engineering, supporting, and promoting against the Roman Catholic Church, from both outside and inside sources.

This *schism* is dominated by men who are extremely liberalistic in their humanistic values, evaluations, contrivances, determinations, methods, theories and opinions, in their adoption of so-called updating their beliefs and practices in a zealous endeavor to have a common relationship and understanding with all men. Many times such zeal can sound or *appear* to be correct, especially when it satisfies a person’s questions, confusion, or problems.

Such a *schism* is being headed by the so-called *intellectual* theologians who feel a personal disagreement of conduct in many areas of Holy Mother Church, or because of their aggravation

due to personal disputes antagonized by the upper echelon authority.

A *schism* is not the answer to correcting any errors, wrongs, or disputes in Holy Mother Church, whether they be due to obedience regulations, methods of administration, or clerical religious differences. Sound thinking from dedicated religious men says to approach the situations in an orderly manner and use all the proper means to clarify, classify, communicate and reach final determinations that Christ would endorse as His Way of accomplishing things.

Ego is the basis for most of the abusive mudslinging, characterized through slander, gossip and emotional insensitivity, debasing the real meaning of being a *Christian* as God intended it to be.

It is especially the bad example of so many priests or ex-priests showing poor taste in their petty innuendos, plus their deliberate *lack* of sincere humility, piety and dignity that is expected because of each man's commitment to God for the Souls of men.

It is time for men to stop talking about *Christianity* or *being a Christian* and *act like one*.

Schisms don't support Christianity. They divide it into a form or practice that allows them more immoral freedoms and diminishes the structure of what God gave the Ten Commandments for, and why He established and instituted the One True Church.

Remember to emphasize that you are a Roman Catholic, don't just say you are Catholic.

Stop the *schism* through more prayer and concentration on what it really means to be a Christian in Holy Mother Church.

“CHARITY”

“What is charity? Where are its bounds? What are its limits? In what phase of life should it be exercised? Under what conditions is charity necessary? Are there strict rules regarding the act of charity? Is charity an ability that some one person has and not another person? Is charity restricted to a race, a color, or a creed? Is charity just for monetary needs, or just when another person is hungry or when clothing is needed? How do you exercise your feelings about charity, your actions in charity, and/or your example of charity?”

Most people consider charity only a necessary act when there is an obvious need for action to be taken. This is a ridiculous idea of what charity encompasses, includes, or encourages.

Charity is a daily act of living. Charity has its *verbal* participation which encompasses consideration, politeness, humility, discretion, manners, and an inward desire to act

with respect to another human being for the benefit of all concerned.

Charity is *action* when one's self is set aside for the benefit of another human being. Charity is tact in many situations. Charity is compassion, consideration, concern, consolation, aiding a situation, a person, or a cause, to have a sound logical solution or result. Charity benefits everyone when it is done with grace, poise, dignity, and sincere willingness to perform for the benefit of another person.

Most people consider charity on a totally material or physical evaluation. Charity is much more than this. God Himself showed us a tremendous Act of Charity in our very creation, for this was the Ultimate Gift of Love to man. His Acts of Charity to us are too numerous to mention, but it is easy to see His Act of Charity in the Ten Commandments, in the Establishing of Holy Mother Church, and in giving Himself and of Himself to institute the vocation of the Priesthood for the benefit of each man's Soul.

Charity has no limits, has no boundaries, and is for every race, color

and creed. Charity should be in the hearts and the minds of all people.

The opposite of charity is, of course, selfishness, self-love, a lack of integrity, a lack of dignity, a lack of respect for God, and all other people, and there is no excuse for a lack of charity from anyone.

Many times a lack of dignity, a lack of consideration or selfishness, provoke uncharitable reactions and actions. It is necessary that all men look at charity not just as a symbolism, but as an act of responsibility that must be practiced daily, even momentarily.”

“HUMOR”

“There are many kinds of humor and there are many people who feel that humor is the only way they can get attention. There is fun humor, there is funny humor, and there is clever humor. Also, there is *sick* humor. Sometimes it is difficult for some people to determine what is truly good humor and what is nonsensical or sick humor.

People who enjoy good humor are repulsed by sick humor because sick humor is always tinged or saturated with insults, abrasive remarks, impure actions or impure speech. Sick humor deals with an undignified look at one's self and other people. Also, sick humor has a way of baiting another person into many regretful actions or responses.

Sick humor is beneath a decent human being. It is degrading, demoralizing, and is enjoyed only by people who subject themselves to a degenerate or abusive form of life. When humor is not offensive, it is good.

When humor is not risky or risqué, it can be relaxing to everyone present, and can be the note of charity that so many times is needed in difficult times.

The next time you laugh at humor or you are encouraged to pass it on, ask yourself the necessary questions: Is it degrading? Does it diminish my Soul? Will it cast a shadow of impurity upon my Soul, or will it lift the spirits and give a moment of joy where I spread it or take part in it? Is it good example to everyone else, and how will it influence everyone else?

Humor many times is not looked upon in its true value, but is exercised by immature people who use it only as a *tool* for attention, not really seeing it for its beautiful purpose God intended.”

“THE SOUL STANDARD”

“What do you accept for yourself first, then what is acceptable by you as a normal, natural form of moral values and moral standards?”

Do you have a habit of making excuses for what you feel is normally okay even when you feel uncomfortable with it?

Do you have a habit of justifying many things by saying it is part of growing up, it is a means to maturing, it is a process of recognizing facts, it is a time of understanding truths, it is a learning mechanism to seek logic?

**Do you really go through all these determinations before you act?
NO, YOU DON'T.**

For the most part people justify everything that is comfortable for them so they are not confronted with the realization of a decision that could border on disaster or being totally wrong.

For instance, TV displays many justifications for immorality, setting up standards of foul, corrupt, indecent, vile situations surrounding the lives of many people. A vulgar exotic dancer is also a social worker, a teacher, a counselor. Immoral shows are put under the guise of entertainment, and throughout the show the justification for why a person or persons arrive at sordid intimacies is totally justified by the predicaments they get into, their unhappiness in life, the traps that other people set for them that they cannot escape from, and so on, and so on, and so on.

The *justification* does not absolve the participants from total mortal, grievous sin, but the writer or the director uses the mechanical devices of compassion, sympathy, understanding, tears, emotion, as a means to permit the immorality, and also justification for the immorality.

What has happened to decent living?

What has happened to real clean fun?

What will turn people around to seeing the privilege of their responsibility for their actions?

What will encourage people to stop being fretful over disillusionment and have the courage and the strength to conquer it? What will force people to stand up against wrong, fight the depression of the bad breaks, and conquer the situation with dignity, integrity, a code of ethics, and sound moral values and sound moral standards?

We have been given to believe that people must all succumb to vileness, to sadism, to sexual immorality. It is a conditioning of the mind that has been going on for a long time. It is downright brainwashing into a submissive society that will respond to being led around by the nose.

People are shouting, 'Jesus,' they are shouting, 'The Lord,' they are shouting, 'Alleluia,' but they are omitting a very important ingredient: stability of the will, the ability to make a decision that does not agree with society, but is sound for one's own Soul and for the Souls of society.

People talk about the gold standard. Tonight we should talk about the Soul Standard, and begin a campaign to put people back on the Soul Standard. This will become a better world. People will become more tranquil and it will set a sound moral standard of living for the whole world.”
